While all things were in quiet
silence and the night was in the midst of
her course, Thine almighty Word, O Lord,
leaped down from heaven from Thy royal
throne'
(Introit, from the Book of Wisdom).

We return to the 'silence' of the night of the birth of the Lord: and yet there is the 'Gloria' of the angels, acclaiming God, who became man. You will notice in the liturgy of this Sunday, references to the kingship of Christ. We have seen this in the introit, when Christ's royal throne in heaven is mentioned, and the alleluia tells us that 'the Lord hath reigned'.

When we come to the manger, we adore the King of kings and the Lord of lords. Every time we visit Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament we do the same. This is a marvelous thought to have when we visit every Catholic Church, which has the true presence of Christ in the tabernacle. You may know that the word 'Bethlehem' means 'house of bread'. This is a sign that our saviour, born of the Blessed Virgin Mary in Bethlehem, wishes us to remain with Him, to receive Him worthily in Holy Communion and to adore him, as the angels and shepherds adored Him in His humility and poverty, when he appeared on earth. Let us adore Him at the manger, and for every more, in the most Holy Sacrament of the altar, where he shows forth his glory, 'full of grace and truth' (prologue of St. John's Gospel).

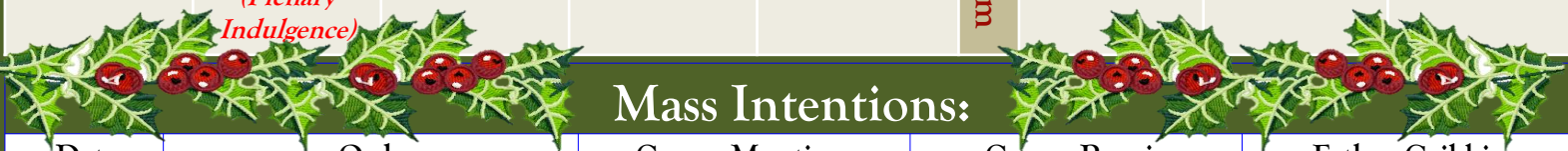
