Feast of the Epiphany



Chalking of the lintel.

It is traditional for parish priests to bless chalk for each family so that they may mark the names of the three Magi over their doors, in the blessing of homes as a witness of their faith and protection against evil.

It is customary to write the formula with blessed chalk as follows:

20 (year) + C (Caspar)+M (Melchior)+B (Balthazar) + 19 (year) The three names are traditionally given to the three wise men or Magi. If you want one of the Priests of Ss PPP to bless your Home, please contact the Shrine.
