## Sunday 3<sup>rd</sup> February External Solemnity of the Purification of our Lady (Candlemass)

10.30am: Blessing of the candles,  
Procession & Sung Mass  
Blessing of the throats (St Blaise)  
at the end of Mass.



## Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary

This Sunday we keep the feast or 'external solemnity' of the Purification of the Blessed Virgin Mary. In English-speaking countries, it tends to be known by the beautiful name 'Candlemas'. In Dutch-speaking countries it is called 'lichtmis', 'lightmass'. This is because the candles used in church for the liturgy, and by the faithful, are blessed, and there is a procession. It brings to an end the period of Christmas. What does this all mean? Our Lady, of course, did not require any 'purification' as she was immaculately conceived and had no original sin, and did not commit actual sin. The immaculate virgin mother of God was merely fulfilling the Jewish law for women whom had given birth, and her 'first born' and only child, the 'new Adam' Jesus Christ, was offered to God.

The lights of the candles at Candlemas remind us of the light of Christ which shone in the temple at Our Lord's Presentation, which was recognised by Simeon and Anna. Both were granted their wish to see the messiah, who would definitively redeem Israel and the rest of mankind. God, the Incarnate Word Jesus Christ, revealed Himself in the temple as he had revealed Himself to the shepherds and the wise men at Christmas.

How important is the light of Christ for our world and the lives of many, which are often shrouded in darkness. May the light of Christ, which we are invited to carry on this great feast day, be taken in our hearts and brought to others. We have a precious treasure which we ought to share: our Catholic Faith.

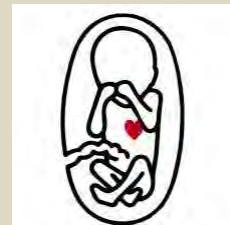
