



Three priests for the Dome and a Third Restoration Project

Please help for the restoration of chapels of Our Lady and the Sacred Heart at the shrine! We need your financial help for this project! Thank you.

In September 2016, Canon Montjean, priest-in-charge, was notified that Heritage Lottery Fund (HLF) had awarded Ss Peter & Paul and St Philomena's a third project, this time to restore the two beautiful marble side chapels. The total possible HLF Award will be £250k, if we can raise enough match funding in time.

On 13th December 2016, The Dome was notified of an early £10k Christmas Present from National Churches Trust towards this match funding target, reducing total needed to £7k by March 2017. Officially launching the New Year Fundraising Appeal Canon Montjean declared, "We have restored about a third of the roofs and brickwork in our previous two projects so far, but when it rains, water seeps through the side chapel roofs. That's the priority areas now so we've still got a lot of work to do. When our friends give for this project, they will know their donation will help preserve Our Lady's beautiful statue and lapis lazuli marble altar."

In conjunction with the building work, HLF require that we engage even more people and different audiences through Activities. We have decided to target young people, who possibly don't know the church or our Faith yet, but whom are nonetheless called by Him. Inspired by St Francis de Sales example of true charity, we hope to imaginatively engage and teach through these 'heritage' activities, informing our young people of some of the rich traditions of our beautiful Faith. A graphically designed Heritage Education Pack with children's audio tour will encourage schools to use the building as a cross-curricular resource to enjoy the art, history, design and in the process, realise the heritage of our Faith. Children will meet some Wallasey characters from 1941, recorded by local drama students in short audio scenarios, to show them what life and traditions were like then.



Canon Montjean, said, "With three, young priests based in New Brighton, supporting each other, this funding will help them to begin their work to 'restore the past to build our future'. We provide the opportunities for engagement and pray that the Holy Spirit does the rest." He added, "The preparation and match funding work has already started, so it is with great hope that I entrust the future of this project to our kind benefactors who have helped us achieve so much, for so many souls, so far. Thank you and may God bless you all."
