If you went on the Scaffolding Tour in September, you may have spotted that the three Clerestory windows (above St Philomena's altar) were in a bad state. Can you see the hole in the frame that was revealed when Mark, our architect touched it.

This was not part of the National Lottery Project, and only discovered once the nave was scaffolded. They badly needed restoration. We applied to NCT to help with this extra maintenance cost. I am delighted to announce that we have been awarded a Foundation Grant of £4868 which is 50% of the repair cost. Hopefully the newly restored windows will be reinstalled very soon.

## Indulgences for the souls of the Faithful Departed

As in 2020, the Apostolic Penitentiary has confirmed that you can obtain a plenary indulgence for the faithful departed on any particular day during the whole month of November for a total of eight days, which need not be consecutive.

The indulgence is granted to those who visit a cemetery and pray, even if only mentally for the faithful departed.

The usual conditions apply:

- 1) Only one plenary indulgence can be granted per day.
- 2) It is necessary to be in a state of grace, at least by the time the work is completed.
- 3) Freedom from attachment to sin, even venial sin is necessary: by this is meant attachment to a particular sin, or sin in general. Otherwise the indulgence is only partial.
- 4) Holy Communion must be received each time the indulgence is sought.
- 5) Prayers must be recited for the intention of the Holy Father on each day the indulgence is sought. No particular prayers are prescribed. One Our Father and Hail Mary suffice.
- 6) A sacramental confession must be made within a week of completion of the prescribed work. One confession made during the week, made with the intention of gaining all the indulgences, suffices.

PROPERs of the MASS  
Last Sunday after Pentecost

INTROIT *Jer. 29. 11, 12, 14*

The Lord saith: I think thoughts of peace, and not of affliction: you shall call upon Me, and I will hear you; and I will bring back your captivity from all places. Ps. Lord, Thou hast blessed Thy land: Thou hast turned away the captivity of Jacob. V. Glory be to the Father.

COLLECT

Stir up the wills of Thy faithful people, we beseech Thee, O Lord: that more earnestly seeking the fruit of good works, they may receive more abundantly the gifts of Thy loving kindness. Through our Lord.

EPISTLE *Col. 1. 9-14*

Brethren: We cease not to pray for you, and to beg that you may be filled with the knowledge of the will of God, in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; that you may walk worthy of God, in all things pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God; strengthened with all might according to the power of His glory, in all patience and long suffering with joy; giving thanks to God the Father; who hath made us worthy to be partakers of the lot of the saints in light; who hath delivered us from the power of darkness, and hath translated us into the kingdom of the Son of His love, in whom we have redemption through His blood, the remission of sins.

GRADUAL *Psalms 43. 8-9*

Thou hast delivered us, O Lord, from them that afflict us: and hast put them to shame that hate us. V. In God we will glory all the day: and in Thy name we will give praise for ever.

ALLELUIA *Psalms 129. 1-2*

Alleluia, alleluia. From the depths I have cried to Thee, O Lord: Lord, hear my prayer. Alleluia.

GOSPEL *Matthew 13. 25-30*

At that time, Jesus said to His disciples: When you shall see the abomination of desolation, which was spoken of by Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place; (he that readeth, let him understand;) then they that are in Judea, let them flee to the mountains; and he that is on the housetop, let him not come down to take anything out of his house; and he that is in the field, let him not go back to take his coat. And woe to them that are with child, and that give suck, in those days. But pray that your flight be not in the winter, or on the sabbath: for there shall be then great tribulation, such as hath not been found from the beginning of the world until now neither shall be: and unless those days had been shortened, no flesh should be

saved; but for the sake of the elect, those days shall be shortened. Then if any man shall say to you: Lo, here is Christ, or there; do not believe him; for there shall arise false Christs, and false prophets, and shall show great signs and wonders, insomuch as to deceive (if possible) even the elect. Behold I I have told it to you beforehand: if therefore they shall say to you: Behold He is in the desert, go ye not out; behold He is in the closets, believe it not. For as lightning cometh out of the east, and appeareth even into the west, so shall also the coming of the Son of man be. Wheresoever the body shall be, there shall the eagles also be gathered together. And immediately after the tribulation of those days, the sun shall be darkened, and the moon shall not give her light, and the stars shall fall from heaven, and the powers of heaven shall be moved; and then shall appear the sign of the Son of man in heaven, and then shall all the tribes of the earth mourn; and they shall see the Son of man coming in the clouds of heaven with much power and majesty; and He shall send His angels with a trumpet and a great voice, and they shall gather together His elect from the four winds, from the farthest parts of the heavens to the utmost bounds of them. And from the fig tree learn a parable: when the branch thereof is now tender, and the leaves come forth, you know that summer is nigh. So you also, when you shall see all these things, know ye that it is nigh even at the doors. Amen I say to you that this generation shall not pass till all these things be done. Heaven and earth shall pass away, but My words shall not pass away.
