I BELIEVE IN ONE GOD

"Father, Son, and Holy Ghost: a Trinity of one divine substance."



After having celebrated the feast of Pentecost and the descent of the Holy Ghost upon the Apostles as promised by our Blessed Lord to fulfil God's revelation to mankind, our Holy Mother Church proposes to the consideration of her children the ineffable mystery of the one true God as Father, Son, and Holy Spirit: the Most Holy Trinity. We profess with faith what we could not otherwise know, and by our firm and sure faith, we come to understand: "Whosoever will be saved, before all things it is necessary that he hold the catholic faith. Which faith unless everyone do keep whole and undefiled, without doubt he shall perish everlastingly. The Catholic Faith is this: that we worship one God in Trinity, and Trinity in unity, neither confounding the Persons, nor dividing the essence. For there is one Person of the Father, another of the Son, and another of the Holy Ghost. The Godhead of the Father, of the Son, and of the Holy Ghost is all one; the glory equal, the majesty coeternal." I believe in one God.

PROPERs of the MASS

Trinity Sunday

INTROIT *Tobias 12. 6*

Blessed be the Holy Trinity and undivided Unity: we will give glory to Him, because He hath shown His mercy to us. Ps. O Lord, our Lord, how wonderful is Thy Name in all the earth! V. Glory be to the Father.

COLLECT

O almighty and everlasting God, who hast granted to Thy servants, in confessing the true Faith, to acknowledge the glory of the eternal Trinity, and in the power of Majesty to adore the Unity: we beseech Thee, that by steadfastness in the same Faith, we may ever be defended against all adversity. Through our Lord.

EPISTLE *Romans 11. 33–36*

O the depths of the riches of the wisdom and of the knowledge of God! How incomprehensible are His judgments, and how unsearchable His ways! For who hath known the mind of the Lord? Or who hath been His counsellor? Or who hath first given to Him, and recompense shall be made Him? For of Him, and by Him, and in Him, are all things: to Him be glory for ever. Amen.

GRADUAL *Daniel 3. 55, 56*

Blessed art Thou, O Lord, that beholdest the depths and sittest above the Cherubim. V. Blessed art Thou, O Lord, in the firmament of heaven, and worthy of praise forever.

ALLELUIA *Daniel 3. 52*

Alleluia, alleluia. V. Blessed art Thou, O Lord, the God of our fathers, and worthy to be praised forever. Alleluia.

GOSPEL *Matthew 28. 18–20*

At that time Jesus said to His disciples: All is power given to Me in heaven and on earth. Going therefore, teach ye all nations, baptizing them in the Name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Ghost, teaching them to observe all things whatsoever I have commanded you. And behold I am with you all days, even to the consummation of the world.

OFFERTORY *Tobias 12. 6*

Blessed be God the Father, and the only begotten Son of God, and also the Holy Ghost; because He hath shown His mercy to us.

SECRET

Sanctify, we beseech Thee, O Lord, our God, by the invocation of Thy holy Name, the Sacrifice we offer, and by it make of us an everlasting offering unto Thee. Through our Lord.

PREFACE OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

It is truly meet and just, right and for our salvation, that we should at all times, and in all places, give thanks to Thee, holy Lord, Father almighty, eternal God: Who, together with Thine only-begotten Son and the Holy Ghost, art one God, one Lord: not in the Oneness of a single Person, but in the Trinity of one substance. For what by Thy revelation we believe of Thy glory, the same do we believe of Thy Son, the same of the Holy Ghost, without difference or separation; so that in confessing the true and eternal Godhead, in It we should adore distinction in persons, unity in Essence, and equality in Majesty: in praise of which Angels and Archangels, Cherubim also and Seraphim day and night exclaim, without end and with one voice saying:

COMMUNION *Tobias 12. 6*

We bless the God of heaven, and before all living we will praise Him; because He has shown His mercy to us.

POSTCOMMUNION

O Lord, our God, may our reception of this Sacrament and our acknowledgment of the holy and eternal Trinity and Its undivided Unity profit us unto health of mind and body. Through our Lord.
