TALE OF TWO CITIES

"Seek ye first the Kingdom of God and His justice."



The central theme of today's Holy Mass is a *Tale of Two Cities*. "Two cities," tells us St. Augustine, "were formed by two loves: the City of Man formed by the love of self even unto the contempt of God and the City of God formed even unto the contempt of self. The former glories in itself; the latter glories in God." "No one can serve two masters," decrees our Divine Saviour in today's holy Gospel, "for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will sustain the one and despise the other." Our blessed Lord puts us on guard against the attractiveness of earthly goods, warning us that our anxiety and solicitude concerning material things, our ease of life and our personal sense of security will only keep us from living according to the Spirit of God. The Christian soul who tries to follow the voice of God and the axioms of the world will never be content, for she will neither experience the immense joy of knowing that she belongs entirely to God, nor will she have the total satisfaction of being able to follow all the allurements of the world. The first will be impeded by the soul's infidelity to God's love, and the second will be hindered by the holy fear of God never entirely erased from her conscious. Only by giving ourselves unreservedly to Christ will we find that joy for which our hearts were created: it is the joy of knowing that we are so fully loved by God that we can entrust our whole being to His divine goodness.

PROPERs of the MASS

Fourteenth Sunday after Pentecost

INTROIT *Psalm 83. 10–11*

Behold, O God, our protector, and look on the face of Thy Christ: for better is one day in Thy courts above thousands. Ps. How lovely are Thy tabernacles, O Lord of hosts! my soul longeth and fainteth for the courts of the Lord. V. Glory be to the Father.

COLLECT

Keep, we beseech Thee, O Lord, Thy Church with perpetual peace; and because the frailty of man without Thee cannot but fall, keep us ever by Thy help from all things hurtful, and lead us to all things profitable to our salvation. Through our Lord.

EPISTLE *Galatians 5. 16–24*

Brethren: Walk in the spirit, and you shall not fulfil the lusts of the flesh: for the flesh lusteth against the spirit, and the spirit against the flesh; for these are contrary one to another, so that you do not the things that you would. But if you are led by the spirit, you are not under the law. Now the works of the flesh are manifest, which are fornication, uncleanness, immodesty, luxury, idolatry, witchcrafts, enmities, contentions, emulations, wraths, quarrels, dissensions, sects, envies, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like; of the which I foretell you, as I have foretold to you, that they who do such things shall not obtain the kingdom of God. But the fruit of the spirit is: charity, joy, peace, patience, benignity, goodness, longanimity, mildness, faith, modesty, continency, chastity. Against such there is no law. And they that are Christ's have crucified their flesh with the vices and concupiscences.

GRADUAL *Psalm 117. 8–9*

It is good to confide in the Lord, rather than to have confidence in man. V. It is good to trust in the Lord, rather than to trust in princes.

ALLELUIA *Psalm 94. 1*

Alleluia, alleluia. V. Come, let us praise the Lord with joy; let us joyfully sing to God our Saviour. Alleluia.

GOSPEL *Matthew 6. 24–33*

At that time Jesus said to His disciples: No man can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or he will sustain the one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon. Therefore I say to you, be not solicitous for your life, what you shall eat, nor for your body, what you shall put on. Is not the life more than the meat, and the body more than the raiment?

Behold the birds of the air; for they neither sow nor do they reap, nor gather into barns, and your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are you not of much more value than they? And which of you, by taking thought, can add to his stature one cubit? And for raiment why are you solicitous? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they labour not, neither do they spin; but I say to you, that not even Solomon in all his glory was arrayed as one of these. Now if God so clothes the grass of the field, which is today, and tomorrow is cast into the oven, how much more you, O ye of little faith! Be not solicitous therefore saying, what shall we eat, or what shall we drink, or wherewith shall we be clothed, for after all these things do the heathens seek. For your Father knoweth that you have need of all these things. Seek ye therefore first the Kingdom of God, and His justice; and all these things shall be added unto you.

OFFERTORY *Psalm 33. 8–9*

The angel of the Lord shall encamp round about them that fear Him, and shall deliver them: O taste and see that the Lord is sweet!

SECRET

Grant, we beseech Thee, O Lord, that the saving oblation we offer, may both atone for our sins, and propitiate for us Thine almighty power. Through our Lord.

PREFACE OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

It is truly meet and just, right and for our salvation, that we should at all times, and in all places, give thanks to Thee, holy Lord, Father almighty, eternal God: Who, together with Thine only-begotten Son and the Holy Ghost, art one God, one Lord: not in the Oneness of a single Person, but in the Trinity of one substance. For what by Thy revelation we believe of Thy glory, the same do we believe of Thy Son, the same of the Holy Ghost, without difference or separation; so that in confessing the true and eternal Godhead, in It we should adore distinction in persons, unity in Essence, and equality in Majesty: in praise of which Angels and Archangels, Cherubim also and Seraphim day and night exclaim, without end and with one voice saying:

COMMUNION *Matthew 6. 33*

Seek first the Kingdom of God: and all things shall be added unto you, saith the Lord.

May Thy Sacraments, O God, at all times purify and strengthen us, and through them may we attain to eternal salvation. Through our Lord.
