## PUT ON THE NEW MAN

*"Friend, how did you come in here not having on a wedding garment?"*



Today's Gospel outlines the tragic story—so true even today—of human ingratitude, which rejects God's mercy and is indifferent to His gifts and invitations. The parable of the king who invites his guests to the marriage feast of his son delineates primarily the invitation to the Christian life of grace, incumbent upon all who desire eternal life in heaven. However, we can also see in it a special, individual invitation to follow a particular vocation: a call to the priesthood or to consecrated religious life. In order to respond to this invitation, our assent must be more than nominal. It must involve the sincere and profound commitment of our whole self to the God who created us and who loves us with an eternal and everlasting love. For this blessed soul, unworthy though he be, he is invited each day to "put on the new man" and to correspond to the graces offered to him at every moment. A vocation attains its full realization only by our continual fidelity to God's invitations. We may ask though, "why are only a few chosen?" It is because only a few will correspond each day with the grace of their vocation, accepting their divine call, and who always say yes to grace. O Lord, send us many holy priests and. Religious vocations!

# PROPERS of the MASS

## Eighteenth Sunday after Pentecost

### INTROIT *Psalm 77. 1*

I am the salvation of the people, saith the Lord: in whatever tribulation they shall cry to Me, I will hear them; and I will be their Lord for ever. Ps. Attend, O My people, to My law; incline your ears to the words of My mouth. Glory be to the Father.

### COLLECT

Almighty and merciful God, in Thy goodness keep us, we beseech Thee, from all things hurtful; that we, being ready both in body and soul, may accomplish those things which belong to Thy service. Through our Lord.

### EPISTLE *Ephesians 4. 23-28*

Brethren: Be ye renewed in the spirit of your mind, and put on the new man, who according to God is created in justice and holiness of truth. Wherefore, putting away lying, speak ye the truth every man with his neighbour, for we are members one of another. Be angry, and sin not. Let not the sun go down upon your anger. Give not place to the devil. He that stole, let him now steal no more: but rather let him labour, working with his hands the thing which is good, that he may have something to give to him that suffereth need.

### GRADUAL *Psalm 140. 2*

Let my prayer be directed as incense in Thy sight, O Lord. The lifting up of my hands as evening sacrifice.

### ALLELUIA *Psalm 140. 1*

Alleluia, alleluia. Give glory to the Lord, and call upon His name: declare His deeds among the nations. Alleluia.

### GOSPEL *Matthew 22. 1-14*

At that time: Jesus spoke to the chief priests and the Pharisees in parables, saying: The kingdom of heaven is likened to a king, who made a marriage for his son; and he sent his servants, to call them that were invited to the marriage, and they would not come. Again he sent other servants, saying: Tell them that were invited: Behold, I have prepared my dinner; my beeves and fatlings are killed, and all things are ready; come ye to the marriage. But they neglected: and went their ways, one to his farm, and another to his merchandise; and the rest laid hands on his servants, and having treated them contumeliously, put them to death. But when the king had heard of it, he was angry; and sending his armies, he destroyed those murderers, and burnt their city. Then he saith to his servants: The marriage indeed is ready, but they that were

invited were not worthy. Go ye therefore into the highways, and as many as you shall find, call to the marriage. And his servants going forth into the ways, gathered together all that they found, both bad and good; and the marriage was filled with guests. And the king went in to see the guests; and he saw there a man who had not a wedding garment: and he saith to him: Friend, how camest thou in hither, not having on a wedding garment? but he was silent. Then the king said to the waiters: Bind his hands and feet, and cast him into the exterior darkness: there shall be weeping and gnashing of teeth. For many are called, but few are chosen.

### OFFERTORY *Psalm 137. 7*

If I shall walk in the midst of tribulation, Thou wilt quicken me, O Lord; and Thou wilt stretch forth Thy hand against the wrath of my enemies, and Thy right hand shall save me.

### SECRET

Grant, we beseech Thee, O Lord, that these gifts, which we offer in the sight of Thy majesty, may be unto us for salvation. Through our Lord.

### PREFACE OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

It is truly meet and just, right and for our salvation, that we should at all times and in all places, give thanks unto Thee, O holy Lord, Father almighty, everlasting God: Who, together with Thine only-begotten Son, and the Holy Ghost, are one God, one Lord: not in the oneness of a single Person, but in the Trinity of one substance. For what we believe by Thy revelation of Thy glory, the same do we believe of Thy Son, the same of the Holy Ghost, without difference or separation. So that in confessing the true and everlasting Godhead, distinction in persons, unity in essence, and equality in majesty may be adored. Which the Angels and Archangels, the Cherubim also and Seraphim do praise: who cease not daily to cry out with one voice saying:

### COMMUNION *Psalm 118. 4-5*

Thou hast commanded Thy commandments to be kept most diligently: O that my ways may be directed to keep Thy justifications.

### POSTCOMMUNION

May the healing power of Thy grace, O Lord, mercifully rid us of all perversity of heart, and make us ever cleave to Thy commandments. Through the same Lord.
