A KING ON A CROSS

"For this I was born, and for this I came into the world; that I should give testimony of the truth. Everyone that is of the truth, hears my voice."



Atop the crucifix in every Christian home are the letters, "I.N.R.I." They abbreviate in Latin the same inscription nailed to the wood of the Cross above the head of our Blessed Lord as He hung there upon the gibbet: *Iesus Nazaraenus Rex Iudaeorum*, Jesus of Nazareth King of the Jews. Acclaimed with joy by men, women, and children as Jesus entered into the holy city of Jerusalem, these same words would be jeered in mockery six days hence as the mob would cry, "Crucify Him!" Folly to the world and a scandal to the perfidious, we profess with undaunted faith the reality before our very eyes: our King is on a cross. This ignominious instrument of execution in the eyes of men is indeed the glorious throne of the Son of God in the eyes of the angels. It is transformed before the eyes of all those who remain close to it until the end. This is the drama of Holy Week. This is the mystery of our redemption as this timeless truth is made accessible to us once again through the tangible reality of the Sacred Liturgy. The source of our salvation is made present to us in the sanctuary beneath the hallowed veils of this week's sacred rites, and in order for us to receive their ineffable gift, we must be present. Let us, therefore, put aside for this one week all our worldly preoccupations, concerns, and pleasures, which profit nothing to a soul bereft of the love of God, and let us draw near and hold fast to our King upon the Cross.

It is also a pious practice to remain in silent recollection and prayer from 12 noon until 3pm, as this is when our Lord was on the Cross.
