

WHAT SHALL I DO?

"If by the Spirit you mortify the deeds of the flesh, you shall live."



The Holy Sacrifice today presents to us the two-fold expression of God's eternal love towards His creation: namely, His divine justice and mercy. We read in the Epistle that "we are debtors" to the Holy Spirit, who has sanctified us by His grace in Baptism, and if by the same Spirit, we mortify the deeds of the flesh, we shall truly live! This life (the life of grace) that we are offered does not make us slaves, but sons and daughters. We are truly able to say, "Abba (Father)" as His children and heirs to the kingdom of heaven. If ever we compromise, offend, or denounce our relationship with our loving Father through sin, Jesus (our oldest Brother in grace) has provided for us a means by which we may be reconciled to our heavenly Father. In the Sacrament of Penance, we humbly take our sinful debt to the priest, God's unworthy servant; we ask forgiveness of our sins, and he takes what we deserve upon himself in the Person of Christ and absolves us of our sins, asking not that we pay the debt we should owe, but only to do a small act of salutary penance as an offering to God in thanks for His mercy. What then shall I do for all that the Lord has done for me? "I will take the chalice of salvation and I shall call upon the name of the Lord!"

Grant to us, O Lord, we beseech Thee, the spirit to think and do always such things as are right; that we who cannot exist without Thee, may be able to live according to Thy will. Through our Lord.

EPISTLE Romans 8. 12-17

Brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live according to the flesh; for if you live according to the flesh, you shall die; but if by the Spirit you mortify the deeds of the flesh, you shall live. For whosoever are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God. For you have not received the spirit of bondage again in fear, but you have received the spirit of adoption of sons, whereby we cry: Abba (Father). For the Spirit Himself giveth testimony to our spirit, that we are the sons of God; and if sons, heirs also; heirs indeed of God, and joint heirs with Christ.

Be Thou unto me a God, a protector, and a place of refuge, to save me. V. In Thee, O God, have I hoped: O Lord, let me never be confounded.

ALLELUIA Psalm 47. 2

GOSPEL Luke 16. 1-9

At that time, Jesus spoke to His disciples this parable: There was a certain rich man who had a steward; and the same was accused unto him that he had wasted his goods; and he called him, and said to him: How is it that I hear this of thee? Give an account of thy stewardship, for now thou canst be steward no longer. And the steward said within himself: What shall I do, because my lord taketh away from me the stewardship? To dig, I am not able: to beg, I am ashamed. I know what I will do, that when I shall be put out of the stewardship, they may receive me into their houses. Therefore calling together every one of his lord's debtors, he said to the first: How much dost thou owe my lord? But he said: A hundred barrels of oil. And he said to him: Take thy bill, and sit down quickly, and write fifty. Then he said to another: And how much dost thou owe? Who said: A hundred quarters of wheat. He said to him: Take thy bill, and write eighty. And the lord commended the unjust steward, for as much as he had done wisely: for the children of this world are wiser in their generation than the children of light. And I say to you: Make unto you friends of the mammon of iniquity, that when you shall fail, they may receive you into everlasting dwellings.

Thou wilt save the humble people, O Lord, and wilt bring down the eyes of the proud; for who is God but Thee, O Lord?

Receive, we beseech Thee, O Lord, the gifts of Thy bounty which we bring to Thee, and by the power of Thy grace, may these holy mysteries sanctify our lives in this world and bring us to the joys of eternity. Through our Lord.

PREFACE OF THE MOST HOLY TRINITY

It is truly meet and just, right and for our salvation, that we should at all times, and in all places, give thanks to Thee, holy Lord, Father almighty, eternal God: Who, together with Thine only-begotten Son and the Holy Ghost, art one God, one Lord: not in the Oneness of a single Person, but in the Trinity of one substance. For what by Thy revelation we believe of Thy glory, the same do we believe of Thy Son, the same of the Holy Ghost, without difference or separation; so that in confessing the true and eternal Godhead, in It we should adore distinction in persons, unity in Essence, and equality in Majesty: in praise of which Angels and Archangels, Cherubim also and Seraphim day and night exclaim, without end and with one voice saying:
