Passion Sunday

This Week

Info taken from the New Marian Missal (pages 261, 901, 281)

The Mass of Passion Sunday is full of the thought of the passion of Jesus and of the infidelity of the Jews, whose place in the Kingdom of God was taken by those who were baptized, ie the Christians.

From this day, until Maundy Thursday, at the Masses of the Season the psalm 'Judica me...' is omitted on Sundays and Ferias, as also the 'Gloria Patri' at the Introit and at the Lavabo, but on Feasts they are said as usual. This is to signify the ignominy of Christ's Passion, when His glory was for the time being laid aside; and the whole spirit of the Office and Mass is one of solemn preparation for the great events of the coming Holy Week.



- **Tuesday 19th** is the feast of **St Joseph**, Patron of the universal Church. Intercession of St Joseph prevails with Jesus Christ ("And He was subject to them"). The Son of God spent 30 years assiduously obeying Joseph and Mary! It was sufficient for Joseph, by the least word or sign, to show that he wished Him to do anything, and Jesus immediately obeyed. Our Lord would teach us, that, as He was pleased to be subject to Joseph upon earth, so He is now pleased to grant whatever this Saint asks in heaven.
- **Thursday 21st** is the feast of **St Benedict**, Patron of the Institute. This means there is the opportunity to gain a **plenary indulgence** on Thursday, if you attend Mass and Holy Communion in an Institute Church, under usual conditions of confession within 8 days either side, no attachment to sin and prayer for the Pope.
- **Feast of the Seven Sorrows of the Blessed Virgin Mary** commemorating the martyrdom suffered by Our Lady in union with the Passion of Her Son, especially 'the Compassion of Our Lady'.

INTROIT

Judge me, O God, and distinguish my cause against an ungodly nation: O deliver me from the unjust and deceitful man: for Thou art my God and my strength. Ps. Send out Thy light and Thy truth: they have led me and brought me unto Thy holy hill, even unto Thy tabernacles. Judge me.

COLLECT

We beseech Thee, almighty God, mercifully look upon Thy family: that by Thy great goodness it may be governed in body, and by Thy protection be preserved in mind. Through our Lord.

EPISTLE *Hebrews 9. 11-15*

Brethren: Christ being come, a High Priest of the good things to come, by a greater and more perfect tabernacle, not made with hands, that is, not of this creation: neither by the blood of goats or of calves, but by His own blood, entered once into the Holies, having obtained eternal redemption. For if the blood of goats and of oxen and the ashes of a heifer, being sprinkled, sanctify such as are defiled, to the cleansing of the flesh: how much more shall the blood of Christ, who, by the Holy Ghost, offered Himself unspotted unto God, cleanse our conscience from dead works, to serve the living God? And therefore, He is the Mediator of the new testament: that by means of His death, for the redemption of those transgressions which were under the former testament, they that are called may receive the promise of eternal inheritance, in Christ Jesus our Lord.

GRADUAL

Deliver me, O Lord, from my enemies: teach me to do Thy will. V. My deliverer, O Lord, from the angry nations: Thou wilt lift me up above them that rise up against me: from the unjust man Thou wilt deliver me.

TRACT

Often have they fought against me from my youth. V. Let Israel now say: often have they fought against me from my youth. V. But they could not prevail over me: the wicked have wrought upon my back. V. They have lengthened their iniquities: the Lord who is just will cut the necks of sinners.

GOSPEL *John 8. 46-59*

At that time Jesus said to the multitudes of the Jews: Which of you shall convince Me of sin? If I say the truth to you, why do you not believe Me? He that is of God heareth the

words of God. Therefore you hear them not, because you are not of God. The Jews therefore answered, and said to Him: Do not we say well, that Thou art a Samaritan, and hast a devil? Jesus answered: I have not a devil: but I honour My Father, and you have dishonoured Me. But I seek not My own glory: there is One that seeketh and judgeth. Amen, amen, I say to you: If any man keep My word, he shall not see death for ever. The Jews therefore said: Now we know that Thou hast a devil. Abraham is dead, and the prophets: and Thou sayest: If any man keep My word, he shall not taste death for ever. Art Thou greater than our father Abraham, who is dead? and the prophets are dead, whom dost Thou make Thyself? Jesus answered: If I glorify Myself, My glory is nothing: it is My Father that glorifieth Me, of whom you say that He is your God, and you have not known Him: but I know Him: And if I shall say that I know Him not, I shall be like to you, a liar. But I do know Him and do keep His word. Abraham your father rejoiced that he might see My day: he saw it and was glad. The Jews therefore said to Him: Thou art not yet fifty years old: and hast Thou seen Abraham? Jesus said to them: Amen, amen, I say to you, before Abraham was made, I am. They took up stones therefore to cast at Him: but Jesus hid Himself and went out of the temple.

OFFERTORY

I will confess to Thee, O Lord, with my whole heart: render to Thy servant: I shall live and keep Thy words: enliven me according to Thy word, O Lord.

SECRET

May these offerings, we beseech Thee, O Lord, loosen the bonds of our wickedness, and procure for us the gifts of Thy mercy. Through our Lord.

COMMUNION

This is My Body which shall be delivered for you: this chalice is the new testament in My Blood, saith, the Lord: do this, as often as you receive it, in commemoration of Me.

POSTCOMMUNION

Draw near to us, O Lord, our God, and by Thy unfailing help defend those whom Thy mysteries have refreshed. Through our Lord.

Translation of Prayer for the King sung at the Sunday Sung Mass:

We beseech You, Almighty. God, that your servant Charles, our King, who has been called by Your mercy to rule over this kingdom, may also receive from You an increase of all virtues.
