




Efficacious Prayer

From Divine Intimacy p 506 and The New Marian Missal

O Jesus, make me understand that my prayer is of no avail unless it be made in Your Name; that my faith is vain unless I convert it into works.

This week we prepare for the Ascension (Holy Day of Obligation) on Thursday (9th May) with Rogation Days on Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday. These began in the 5th Century, after earthquakes and calamities beset the diocese of Vienne. St Mamertus, the bishop of Vienne, instituted a penitential procession with public supplications with the Litany of the Saints and psalms. Pope Leo III introduced this to Rome in 816 and it soon became a general observance. 'Rogation' derives from rogare (to ask) as we are trying to appease the anger of God and avert the scourges of His justice, and to pray for the harvest.



Ascension Thursday: Forty days after the Resurrection, Our Lord Jesus Christ, attended by Angels, ascended into heaven, in the sight of His most holy Mother, His Apostles, and disciples to the great wonder of them all. He entered into possession of the Kingdom of Heaven, which He had gained by His sufferings. St Paul declares, "There where the Head has gone, the Body is called to follow!"

Novena preceding the Feast of Pentecost: At SsPPP, we will sing the Veni Creator Hymn to the Holy Ghost during Benediction as a public Novena. All faithful who devoutly participate will be granted an indulgence of 10 years each day - plenary if present at least 5 times, under usual conditions of prayer for the Holy Father, confession and holy communion.

Proper of the Mass for Fifth Sunday after Easter

INTROIT

Declare it with the voice of joy, and make it known, alleluia: declare it even to the ends of the earth: The Lord hath delivered His people, alleluia, alleluia. *Ps.* Shout with joy to God, all the earth, sing ye a psalm to His name: give glory to His praise. V. Glory be to the Father.

COLLECT

O God, from whom all good things do proceed, grant unto Thy humble servants, that by Thy holy inspiration, we may think those things that are right, and under Thy guidance may perform the same. Through our Lord.

EPISTLE James 1. 22-27

Dearly beloved, be ye doers of the word and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. For if a man be a hearer of the word and not a doer, he shall be com pared to a man beholding his own countenance in a glass: for he beheld himself and went his way, and presently forgot what manner of man he was. But he that hath looked into perfect law of liberty and hath continued therein, not becoming a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work: this man shall be blessed in his deed. And if any man think himself to be religious, not bridling his tongue but deceiving his own heart, this man's religion is vain. Religion pure and undefiled before God and the Father is this: To visit the fatherless and widows in their tribulation and to keep one's self unspotted from this world.

ALLELUIA

Alleluia, alleluia. V. Christ is risen, and hath shone upon us, whom He redeemed with His blood. Alleluia. V. I came forth from the Father, and am come into the world: again I leave the world and I go to the Father. Alleluia

GOSPEL John 16. 23-30

At that time Jesus saith to His disciples: Amen, amen, I say to you: If you ask the Father anything in My name, He will give it you. Hitherto you have not asked anything in My name: Ask, and you shall receive, that your joy may be

full. These things I have spoken to you in proverbs. The hour cometh when I will no more speak to you in proverbs but will show you plainly of the Father. In that day you shall ask in My name: and I say not to you that I will ask the Father for you: for the Father Himself loveth you, because you have loved Me and have believed that I came out from God. I came forth from the Father and am come into the world: again I leave the world and I go to the Father. His disciples say to Him: Behold now Thou speakest plainly and speakest no proverb. Now we know that Thou knowest all things and Thou needest not that any man should ask Thee: by this we believe That Thou camest forth from God.

OFFERTORY

O bless the Lord our God, ye peoples, and make the voice of His praise to be heard: who hath set my soul to live, and hath not sufféred my feet to be moved. Blessed be the Lord, Who hath not turned away my prayer, nor His mercy from me, alleluia.

SECRET

Receive, O Lord, the prayers and sacrifices of the faithful, that by these offices of loving devotion we may attain to heavenly glory. Through our Lord.

COMMUNION

Sing unto the Lord, alleluia, sing unto the Lord, and bless His name: show forth His salvation from day to day, alleluia, alleluia.

POSTCOMMUNION

Grant us, O Lord, who have been nourished and strengthened at the heavenly table, both to desire that which is right, and to gain that which we desire. Through our Lord.
