Dear faithful,

With gratitude to God, we celebrate the ordination of six young men to the priesthood this past Thursday, 3rd July. "The harvest is great but the labourers are few;" we need our priests in this ever more secularised world, but your priests also need you. Remember to pray for them to persevere and grow in holiness.

According to the gospels, Our Lord Himself went out into the deserts every so often to avoid the crowds. And so too, our Rector, Canon Montjean will be on holiday for the next two weeks for some much-deserved rest. *Bon voyage, Monsieur le chanoine!* Mass, adoration and confession will be maintained at the normal times, but there will be no Vespers or Compline during the week.

This Sunday is the 4th after Pentecost, with the liturgical colour green recommencing after all

the recent solemnities. The present liturgical season extends up until Advent and the beginning of a new church year. The Gospels present different episodes of Our Lord's life and ministry and, along with the epistle readings, seek to inculcate within us the virtues necessary to the spiritual life.

In the weeks to come, we will also continue with selections from the Penny Catechism on page 3. It is important to deepen or to renew or knowledge of the faith and so we hope this will help!

Speaking of learning more about our Catholic faith, if you have not already attended, you are also invited to join in with Canon Montjean's monthly class on liturgy. The more we learn about the treasures of the Mass, the better we can participate spiritually!

The Penny Catechism

FIRST ARTICLE OF THE CREED *continued*:

23. Has God any body? God has no body; He is a spirit

24. Is there only one God? There is only one God.

25. Are there three Persons in God? There are three Persons in God; God the Father God the Son, and God the Holy Ghost.

26. Are these three Persons three Gods? These three Persons are not three Gods: The Father, the Son and the Holy Ghost are all one and the same God.

27. What is the mystery of the three Persons in one God called? The mystery of the three Persons in one God I called the mystery of the Blessed Trinity.

28. What do you mean by a mystery? By a mystery I mean a truth which is above reason, but revealed by God.

29. Is there any likeness to the Blessed Trinity in your soul? There is this likeness to the Blessed Trinity in my soul: That as in one God there are three Persons, so in my soul there are three powers.

30. Which are the three powers of your soul? The three powers of my soul are my memory, my understanding, and my will.

INTROIT *Psalm 26. 1, 2*

The Lord is my light and my salvation: whom shall I fear? The Lord is the protector of my life: of whom shall I be afraid? My enemies that trouble me have themselves been weakened and have fallen. Grant, we beseech Thee, O Lord, that the course of this world may be so peaceably ordered by Thee, that Thy Church may joyfully serve Thee in quiet devotion. Through our Lord.

EPISTLE *Romans 8. 18-23*

Brethren, I reckon that the sufferings of this time are not worthy to be compared with the glory to come, that shall be revealed in us. For the expectation of the creature waiteth for the revelation of the sons of God. For the creature was made subject to vanity, not willingly, but by reason of him that made it subject in hope; because the creature also itself shall be delivered from the servitude of corruption, into the liberty of the glory of the children of God. For we know that every creature groaneth, and travaileth in pain, even till now; and not only it, but ourselves also, who have the first-fruits of the Spirit, even we ourselves groan within ourselves, waiting for the adoption of the sons of God, the redemption of our body; in Christ Jesus our Lord.

GRADUAL *Psalm 78. 9, 10*

Forgive us our sins, O Lord, lest the Gentiles should at any time say: Where is their God? V. Help us, O God, our Saviour; and for the honour of Thy name, O Lord, deliver us.

ALLELUIA *Psalm 9. 5, 10*
