#### Protecting the Most Vulnerable

*Please find below a letter which the bishop has sent to every priest in the diocese. Make sure your voice is heard in defence of life!*

As you may be aware, on Friday 11 September 2015 the House of Commons is debating and voting on a Private Member's Bill to legalise assisted suicide.

As you will appreciate, this is an extremely important debate and I know that you will do your best to encourage parishioners, as active Catholic citizens, to write to their own Members of Parliament. Any emphasis that people can give of their own positive experiences of the care of the sick and dying will reinforce the case against the argument.

There is further information about the Bill, along with a facility for people to find and e-mail their MP, on the Catholic Bishops' Conference website ([www.catholicnews.org.uk/assisted-suicide](http://www.catholicnews.org.uk/assisted-suicide)). Attached is a draft letter that can be printed and handed out for parishioners who would prefer to contact their MP by post.

On Friday 11 September the House of Commons will debate and vote on a Bill to legalise assisted suicide. This will put the most vulnerable people in our society at risk. Please contact your MP, urging them to attend the debate and vote against the Bill.
