Brownedge Festival 2017  
Saturday 29 April - Friday 5 May

The popular Brownedge Parish and Community Festival, at St Mary's, Brownedge, Bamber Bridge, returns in 2017 for its 18th consecutive year. Festival 2017 will be officially opened by the Mayor of South Ribble on Saturday 29 April with daily opening and events throughout the following week culminating with Festival Finale on the evening of Friday 5 May.

Festival was first held in 2000 to mark the completion of a major refurbishment of St Mary's, Brownedge and, since then, has been held on an annual basis. Every year there is an open art competition and also a digital photography competition. In 2016, nearly 200 entries were received for the art competition and some 130 entries for the digital photography competition. All of the art and photographs are displayed in the Church during Festival week and the Church is decorated with beautiful floral displays, all worth seeing.

The Church is open during each afternoon of Festival week from 1pm for visitors to come and have a look around the beautiful and historic Church with its fine stained glass windows. Refreshments are also available. A number of exhibitions are also in place depicting the history of the area and this year there will also be a special exhibition of the art work of the late Lawrence Cartmell who regularly entered the open art competition. Each day, at least one event is held, sometimes two. This year's exciting programme is as follows:
