## WELCOME TO ST. WALBURGE'S!

The celebration of a patron saint's day is always an important moment in the life of any church. We are happy to welcome you all to this feast-day celebration, especially to first-time visitors. Saint Walburge (d. A.D. 779), daughter of the king of Wessex over 1200 years ago, has given her name to this splendid church. Saint Walburge is buried in Eichstätt, Germany, and her tomb still exudes a **miraculous oil**.

Built in the 1850s by the celebrated architect **J.A. Hansom** for the Jesuits, Saint Walburge's in Preston is known for its **spire** (the tallest non-cathedral spire in the country) as well as its magnificent stained glass windows and striking **hammerbeam roof**. Saint Walburge's is no longer a parish church, but the bishop of Lancaster has designated the church as a '**shrine**' (a church with a special purpose, as opposed to set boundaries), entrusting it with the special mission of providing the sacred liturgy in its traditional Latin form, a timeless treasure of our Catholic faith. St. Walburge's is once again **open every day** for holy Mass, confession, Eucharistic Adoration and personal visits (see schedule at left or visit us online or on facebook). **All are welcome!**

In addition to Gregorian chant, today's Mass features sacred music from the 16<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> centuries, sung in the setting for which these pieces were intended, the holy Mass. (Contributions towards the music, sung by our guests the **Saint Philip Neri Singers** from Manchester, can be given to one of the priests.) After Mass the **Litany of St. Walburge** will be recited at her statue. After the recessional hymn, the priest will return to church to present the little flask containing oil from St. Walburge's tomb to those who wish to venerate it.

## WELCOME TO THE SHRINE CHURCH OF SAINT WALBURGE

The Shrine has been established by the Rt. Rev. Michael Campbell, Bishop of Lancaster, as a centre for daily Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament and for the celebration of the liturgy in the traditional Roman Rite. **ALL ARE WELCOME.** The Shrine is open for personal prayer and visits every day.
