Chair of Unity Octave

18th January – 25th January

The eight days from 18th January (feast of St Peter's Throne at Rome) to 25th January (feast of the Conversion of S. Paul) are kept as the 'Chair of Unity Octave,' a week of prayer for the return of separated Christians to union with the See of Peter. Interestingly enough, this octave of prayer for the return or conversion of separated Christians to the Catholic Church was started by an Anglican minister, Paul Wattson, at the beginning of the 20th century. Father Wattson and his religious community, the Friars of the Atonement, eventually entered the Catholic Church; in 1908 Pope St Pius X officially endorsed this week of prayer. Each day of the octave, there is a special prayer intention.

During this week we will have an additional Collect every day at Mass, 'for the removal of schism,' and just before Benediction every day we will hold the Chair of Unity devotions. We know that 'unity' is an essential mark of the Church: unity in one common faith and unity under one common Shepherd. Unity as such is not something we can create through purely human efforts, and the Church cannot ever lose her essential unity, although individual people and nations may unfortunately separate themselves from that unity. Let us increase our own unity with the Church by praying for stronger faith and greater love for our chief shepherd; and let us pray that those outside the Church may cooperate with God's grace and enter the Church He founded as the instrument of our salvation.
