CATECHESIS ON MARRIAGE

For today's feast of the Holy Family, we briefly interrupt the Liturgy Corner to begin a brief series of columns explaining Christ's teaching on marriage. Even among Catholics, there is a great deal of confusion on this topic nowadays – as the result of dramatic changes in media-driven popular culture and through hostile legislation – and so it is essential to have clear ideas, forming our minds and consciences in keeping with the timeless teaching of the Gospels. – Canon Altiere.

What is marriage?

Created by God at the dawn of human history, marriage is the life-long union of one man and one woman, a union ordered by its very nature to the procreation and upbringing of children, as well as to the mutual aid and support of the spouses themselves. Marriage was not created by the state or even by human beings themselves: it is a gift from God, and an essential part of his plan for the world. Among baptized Christians, this natural union has been elevated to the dignity of a sacrament by Our Lord Jesus Christ. Saint Paul compares the love of husband and wife – with the reciprocal obligations of respect, sacrifice and obedience – to the love of Jesus Christ for his Bride, the Church. The sacrament of matrimony, worthily received (we will speak later about how to prepare for marriage), is a source of grace for the spouses that enables them to achieve holiness in their state of life and to overcome the difficulties that may occasionally arise in their life together.
