Off to Seminary!

Today we say good-bye to a young man from our congregation whom many of you know. **Michael McCowen**, who did the Coast-to-Coast walk this summer with his brother to raise funds for Saint Walburge's, is off to begin his seminary formation with the Institute. Michael has been the M.C. at Saint Walburge's for the last two years and also reinforces the Gregorian chant schola from time to time. We are very grateful for all his help at Saint Walburge's and wish him the best as he begins his preparation for the priesthood. We congratulate his family and thank them for giving their son to Christ's Church for the salvation of souls. I know that I can count on all of you to pray for Michael and the other new seminarians (including **Liam** and **Stuart**, also from the U.K., who spent a few weeks with us in Preston this summer). Can you please contact Canon Altieri with your "contribution" for the Spiritual Bouquet (Masses, Rosaries, holy hours, etc.) which we will send to Michael at the Seminary?

The international seminary of the Institute is located at Gricigliano in the archdiocese of Florence, Italy. The seminary is dedicated to Saint Philip Neri (1515-1595), who was originally from Florence. Priestly formation in the Institute takes seven years: an introductory "year of spirituality," at the end of which the young men receive the cassock and are tonsured; two years of philosophy studies and four years of theology. The seminarians are able to return home briefly after Christmas and Easter and also in the summer. The seminary, with its own olive groves and vineyards (harvested by the seminarians), is based at the beautiful old Villa Martelli; it was converted to religious use in the 1970s by will of the last two countesses, who desired it to serve as a home for the traditional liturgy. Visitors are always very welcome!
