Abstinence and Fasting

Abstinence refers to not partaking of meat on Fridays and on Ash Wednesday. Fasting is a reduction in the quantity of food that we consume. To fulfil the Church's fast, one should limit oneself to one full meal per day. It is permissible to take food two other times without snacking between (two collations which do not add up to a full meal). The only mandatory fast days remaining are Ash Wednesday and Good Friday. On other Fridays of Lent, abstinence is mandatory but the fast is not.

EPISTLE 2 Corinthians 6. 1-10
