And peace to men of goodwill!

From the Glory of God, from the Glory we give to God, depends peace. This peace is given to men of good will, that is, to those who seek to do the Father's will, on earth as in Heaven. Peace is a gift from God, the gift of the early Easter morning: "Peace be with you", of which Christmas is like an echo. We must be the artisans of this peace... we must get to work! This peace is never acquired or won, it is a constant effort because the enemy is there to sow the weeds amidst the good grain. Satan is the divider. Your priests are always very attentive on this subject because the devil before Christmas seeks to divide and destroy, he is enraged by our joy for the mystery of the Incarnation. He does not hesitate, this malicious serpent, to blow on the embers of discord (which means divided heart in Latin), to maintain the fire of resentment and anger or wounded self-love. Let us not return to peace only for the Ukrainian front, let us start at home!

A small resolution for the final sprint before Christmas: let's practice the virtue of benevolence and positive thinking. Let's be good to the point of naivety! Do not let the sun set upon your anger. For example, in a couple or family life, let's use the words "Forgive me" and "I forgive you". To all of you I wish a beautiful Gaudete Sunday, may your joy be perfect and may no one take it away from you.

TRANSLATION OF THE EPISTLE AND GOSPEL Third Sunday of Advent (Gaudete)

Lesson from the letter of St. Paul the Apostle to the Philippians Phil 4:4-7

Brethren: Rejoice in the Lord always; again I say, rejoice. Let your moderation be known to all men. The Lord is near. Have no anxiety, but in every prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your petitions be made known to God. And may the peace of God which surpasses all understanding guard your hearts and your minds in Christ Jesus, our Lord.

Continuation № of the Holy Gospel according to John John 1:19-28

At that time, the Jews sent to John from Jerusalem priests and Levites to ask him, Who are you? And he acknowledged and did not deny; and he acknowledged, I am not the Christ. And they asked him, What then? Are you Elias? And he said, I am not. Are you the Prophet? And he answered, No. They therefore said to him, Who are you? that we may give an answer to those who sent us. What have you to say of yourself? He said, I am the voice of one crying in the desert, 'Make straight the way of the Lord,' as said Isaias the prophet. And they who had been sent were from among the Pharisees. And they asked him, and said to him, Why, then, do you baptise, if you are not the Christ, nor Elias, nor the Prophet? John said to them in answer, I baptise with water; but in the midst of you there has stood One Whom you do not know. He it is Who is to come after me, Who has been set above me, the strap of Whose sandal I am not worthy to loose. These things took place at Bethany, beyond the Jordan, where John was baptising.
