I've always been very impressed by Remembrance Sunday. One of the virtues and glories of the British people is their sense of remembrance and duty. On the continent, there is nothing like it. Here, poppies bloom everywhere, reminding us of the purple fields of wheat in Flanders that became fields of mud. It is vital to keep this memory alive, especially in this individualistic, global society. Our national identity depends on our memory.
