TRANSLATION OF THE EPISTLE AND GOSPEL Trinity Sunday

Lesson from the letter of St. Paul the Apostle to the Romans Rom 11:33-36.

Oh, the depth of the riches of the wisdom and of the knowledge of God! How incomprehensible are His judgments and how unsearchable His ways! For Who has known the mind of the Lord, or who has been His counselor? Or who has first given to Him, that recompense should be made him? For from Him and through Him and unto Him are all things. To Him be the glory forever, Amen.

Continuation ♥ of the Holy Gospel according to Matthew Matt 28:18-20

At that time, Jesus said to His disciples: All power in heaven and on earth has been given to Me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the Name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you; and behold, I am with you all days, even unto the consummation of the world.

Saint Madeleine-Sophie Barat, 1779-1865 Patronness of the Sister Adorers 25th of May (transferred this year)

In the aftermath of the French Revolution, young Madeleine-Sophie contemplates the thought of entering the Carmel, but France is devastated and there are no convents left anymore. Through Father Varin, a Jesuit priest in exile who is trying to restore his religious order, she understands what God wants of her: she is to found a religious community which will be dedicated to the education of young ladies who, by their influence within their families and in their social circles, will later rebuild Christian society. The "Ladies of the Sacred Heart" who are consecrated to the Heart of Jesus, will be "at His feet by their adoration, at His work by their zeal, Carmelites and missionaries all at once."

At her death the congregation counts 3500 sisters and 197 houses around the world. The body of the saint, found incorrupt both 1893 and in 1908, is now laid in St Francis Xavier's church in Paris.

"Our spirit is one of generous and tender love; if this is lacking in us, we do not have the life of the Heart of Jesus, nor do we have His virtues. Meekness and humility: outside of these, there is no fruit for eternal life, no fruit for the children."
