## Spiritual Communion

Though frequent Communion is desirable, the faithful are not required to receive Communion at every Mass. Anyone who thinks they might be carrying the virus or who is afraid of being infected can instead make a spiritual Communion. While public Masses are suspended, this is something to be recommended for those who are in a state of grace. ### An Act of Spiritual Communion

*by Saint Alphonsus Ligouri*
