INTROIT (ISAIAH 9: 6; PSALM 97, 1)

A child is born to us, and a Son is given to us: Whose government is upon His shoulder: and His name shall be called the Angel of great counsel. **Ps.** Sing ye to the Lord a new canticle: because He hath done wonderful things. Glory be to the Father.

COLLECT

O God, Who by the fruitful virginity of Blessed Mary hast bestowed upon mankind the rewards of eternal salvation: grant, we beseech Thee, that we may experience her intercession for us, through whom we have been made worthy to receive the Author of Life, Jesus Christ, Thy Son, our Lord; Who with Thee liveth and reigneth.

EPISTLE (TITUS 2:11-15)

Beloved: The grace of God our Savior hath appeared to all men: Instructing us, that, denying ungodliness and worldly desires, we should live soberly and justly and godly in this world, looking for the blessed hope and coming of the glory of the great God and our Savior Jesus Christ. Who gave himself for us, that he might redeem us from all iniquity and might cleanse to Himself a people acceptable, a pursuer of good works. These things speak and exhort and rebuke with all authority: In Christ Jesus Our Lord.

GRADUAL (PSALM 97: 3, 4, 2)

All the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God: sing joyfully to God, all the earth. The Lord hath made known His salvation: He hath revealed His justice in the sight of the Gentiles.

ALLELUIA (HEB. 1:1, 2)

Alleluia, Alleluia, God, who in divers manners spoke in times past to the fathers by the prophets, last of all in these days has spoken to us by His Son. Alleluia!

GOSPEL (LUKE 2, 21)

At that time, when eight days were fulfilled for the circumcision of the Child, His name was called Jesus, the name given to Him by the Angel before He was conceived in the womb.

OFFERTORY (PSALM 88:12, 15)

Thine are the heavens, and Thine is the earth, the world and the fulness thereof Thou hast founded: justice and judgment are the preparation of Thy throne.

COMMUNION (PSALM 97: 3)
