THE TRANSFIGURATION OF OUR LORD JESUS CHRIST



The Transfiguration (with text from the Gospel for the day) by Jean Bondol, also known as Jean de Bruges, Jean Boudolf, or Jan Baudolf, a Flemish artist who became a court artist of Charles V of France in 1368. This is one of his illuminations in a translation into French of the Vulgate (painted in 1371) which was presented to Charles V by his valet de chambre Jehan Vaudetar. It is now in the Westreen Museum at the Hague.

INTROIT (Ps. 76: 19; 82: 2-3)

Thy lightnings enlightened the world: the earth shook and trembled. Ps. How lovely are Thy tabernacles, O Lord of hosts! my soul longeth and fainteth for the courts of the Lord. Glory be to the Father.

COLLECT

O God, Who in the glorious transfiguration of Thine only-begotten Son didst strengthen the mysteries of the faith by the testimony of the fathers, and Who didst wonderfully foreshow the perfect adoption of Thy children by a voice coming down in a shining cloud: mercifully grant that we be made co-heirs of the King of glory Himself, and grant us to be sharers in that very glory. Through the same Lord.

EPISTLE (II PET. 1: 16-19)

Dearly beloved, We have not followed cunningly devised fables, when we made known to you the power and presence of Our Lord Jesus Christ; but having been made eyewitnesses of His majesty. For He received from God the Father honor and glory: this voice coming down to Him from the excellent glory: This is My beloved Son in Whom I am well pleased, hear ye Him. And this voice we heard brought from Heaven, when we were with Him in the holy mount. And we have the more firm prophetic word, whereunto you do well to attend, as to a light that shineth in a dark place, until the day dawn, and the day-star arise in your hearts.

GRADUAL (Ps. 44: 3, 2)

Thou art beautiful above the sons of men: grace is poured abroad in Thy lips. My heart hath uttered a good word. I speak my works to the King.

ALLELUIA (Wis. 7: 26)

Alleluia, alleluia. He is the brightness of eternal light, the unspotted mirror, and the image of His goodness. Alleluia.

GOSPEL (Mt. 17: 1-9)

At that time, Jesus took Peter, and James, and John his brother, and bringing them up into a high mountain apart: and He was transfigured before them. And His face did shine as the sun, and His garments became white as snow. And behold, there appeared to them Moses and Elias talking with Him. And Peter answering, said to Jesus, Lord, it is good for us to be here; if Thou wilt, let us make here three tabernacles, one for Thee, and one for Moses, and one for Elias. And as he was yet speaking, behold a bright cloud overshadowed them; and lo, a voice out of the cloud, saying This is My beloved Son in Whom I am well pleased, hear ye Him. And the disciples hearing, fell upon their face; and were very much afraid: and Jesus came and touched them, and said to them, Arise, and fear not. And they lifting up their eyes saw no one, but only Jesus. And as they came down from the mountain, Jesus charged them, saying, Tell the vision to no man, till the Son of man be risen from the dead.

OFFERTORY (Ps. 111: 3)

Glory and wealth are in His house: and His justice remaineth forever and ever. Alleluia.

SECRET

Sanctify, we beseech Thee, O Lord, the gifts offered on the glorious Transfiguration of Thine only-begotten Son, and by the splendors of that very illumination cleanse us from the stains of our sins. Through the same Jesus Christ.

COMMUNION (Mt. 17: 9)

Tell the vision you have seen to no man, till the Son of man be risen from the dead.

POSTCOMMUNION

Grant, we beseech Thee, O almighty God, that with the understanding of a purified mind we may follow those sacred mysteries of Thy Son's Transfiguration which we celebrate with our solemn office. Through the same Lord.

FEAST OF ST LAWRENCE 10TH AUGUST (VIGIL ON 9TH AUGUST)

Lawrence is often shown wearing the dalmatic, and holding a martyr's palm branch and the gridiron on which he was tortured to death. He was martyred in 258 during the Valerian persecution of Christians. Pope Sixtus II, who was martyred only days earlier, foretold Lawrence's martyrdom.
