Propers of the Mass on April 14th, 2024

GOOD SHEPHERD SUNDAY

INTROIT (Ps. 32:5, 6, 1)

The earth is full of the mercy of the Lord, alleluia: by the word of the Lord were the heavens made, alleluia, alleluia. Ps. Rejoice in the Lord, O ye righteous: praise is comely for the upright. W Glory be to the Father.

COLLECT

O God, who, by the humility of Thy Son, hast raised up a fallen world, grant to Thy faithful people abiding joy; that those whom Thou hast delivered from the perils of eternal death, Thou mayest cause to enjoy endless happiness. Through the same Lord.

EPISTLE (I PET. 2:21-25)

Dearly beloved, Christ suffered for us, leaving you an example, that you should follow His steps, Who did no sin, neither was guile found in His mouth. Who when He was reviled, did not revile: when He suffered, He threatened not, but delivered Himself to him that judged Him unjustly: who His own self bore our sins in His body upon the tree: that we, being dead to sins, should live to justice: by whose stripes you were healed. For you were as sheep going astray, but you are now converted to the shepherd and bishop of your souls.

Paschal Alleluia (Lk. 24:35; Jn. 10:14)

Alleluia, alleluia. W The disciples knew the Lord Jesus in the breaking of bread. Alleluia. W I am the good shepherd: and I know My sheep, and Mine know Me. Alleluia.

GOSPEL (JN. 10:11-16)

At that time: Jesus said to the Pharisees: I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd giveth his life for his sheep. But the hireling, and he that is not the shepherd, whose own the sheep are not, seeth the wolf coming, and leaveth the sheep, and fleeth: and the wolf catcheth and scat tereth the sheep: and the hireling fleeth, because he is a hireling, and he hath no care for the sheep. I am the good shepherd: and I know Mine, and Mine know Me, as the Father knoweth

Me, and I know the Father: and I lay down My life for My sheep.
And other sheep I have that are not of this fold: them also I must bring, and they shall hear My voice, and there shall be one fold and one shepherd.

O God, my God, to Thee do I watch at break of day: and in Thy name I will lift up my hands, alleluia.

Pope St. Anicetus

Feast day 17th April

Pope Anicetus was Pope from 157 (or 153) to his death in April 168. Anicetus actively opposed the heresies of Gnosticism and Marcionism. He welcomed Polycarp, disciple of St. John the Evangelist, to Rome to discuss the date for celebration of Easter, which remained unsettled for a considerable Anicetus suffered martyrdom during the reign of Emperor Lucius Verus and was buried in the cemetery of Callistus.
