FIFTH SUNDAY AFTER EASTER



and presently forgot what manner of man he was. PASCHAL ALLELUIA (JN. 16: 28)

Alleluia, alleluia! *W* Christ has risen and has given light to us, whom He redeemed with His Blood. Alleluia! *W* John 16:28. I came forth from the Father and have come into the world. Again I leave the world and go to the Father. Alleluia!

GOSPEL (JN. 16: 23-30)

At that time, Jesus said to His disciples: "Amen, amen, I say to you: if you ask the Father anything in my name, he will give it you. Hitherto, you have not asked anything in my name. Ask, and you shall receive; that your joy may be full. "These things I have spoken to you in proverbs. The hour cometh when I will no longer speak to you in proverbs, but will shew you plainly of the Father. In that day, you shall ask in my name: and I say not to you that I will ask the Father for you. For the Father himself loveth you, because you have loved me and have believed that I came out from God. I came forth from the Father and am come into the world: again I leave the world and I go to the Father." His disciples say to him: "Behold, now thou speakest plainly and speakest no proverb. Now we know that thou knowest all things and thou needest not that any man should ask thee. By this we believe that thou camest forth from God."

OFFERTORY (Ps. 65: 8-9, 20)

Bless the Lord our God, you nations; loudly sound His praise. he has given life to my soul, and has not let my feet falter. Blessed be the Lord who has not refused my prayer nor His mercy to me, alleluia!

Sing to the Lord, alleluia! Sing to the Lord, and bless His name; announce His salvation day after day, alleluia, alleluia!

EPISTLE (JAMES 1: 22-27)

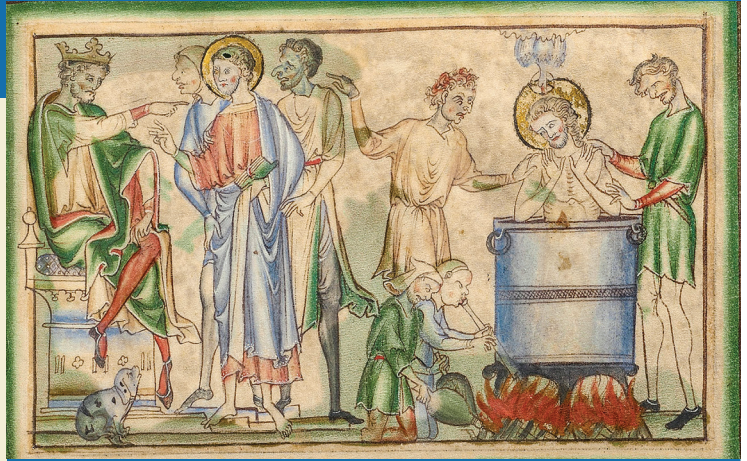
ANNOUNCEMENTS

AT ROME, ST. JOHN BEFORE THE LATIN GATE

6th MAY

While St. John the Apostle was in Ephesus he was asked to sacrifice to the pagan gods. His refusal to do so was reported to the Emperor Domitian, who ordered him brought to Rome to the Latin Gate, where he was plunged into a cauldron of boiling oil. However, aided by the Holy Spirit, he felt no pain and came out both unharmed and invigorated. He was then exiled to the island of Patmos where he wrote the book of the Apocalypse. As he had shown himself willing to die a martyr in imitation of Christ, a church was built by the Latin Gate and the day solemnised as his day of martyrdom.

The image shown here is from an English illuminated manuscript of about 1255-1260. It shows the Emperor Domitian pointing towards St. John in the cauldron of hot oil. A dove, representing the Holy Spirit, hovers over John's head and protects him.
