EXTERNAL SOLEMNITY OF THE FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI



This chalice is the new testament in My Blood; this do ye, as often as you shall drink, for the commemoration of Me. For as often as you shall eat this bread and drink this chalice, you shall show the death of the Lord until He come. Therefore whosoever shall eat this bread, or drink of the chalice of the Lord unworthily, shall be guilty of the Body and the Blood of the Lord. But let a man prove himself; and so let him eat of that bread, and drink of the chalice. For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh judgment to himself, not discerning the Body of the Lord.

GRADUAL (Ps. 144: 15-16)

The eyes of all hope in Thee, O Lord, and Thou givest them meat in due season. ✠ Thou openest Thy hand, and fillest every living creature with Thy blessing.

ALLELUIA (JN 6: 56-57)

Alleluia, alleluia. ✠ My Flesh is meat indeed, and My Blood is drink indeed: he that eateth My Flesh and drinketh My Blood, abideth in Me, and I in him. Alleluia.

SEQUENTIA LAUDA SION, SALVATOREM ...

GOSPEL (JN 6: 56—59)

At that time Jesus said to the multitudes of the Jews: My Flesh is meat indeed, and My Blood is drink indeed. He that eateth My Flesh, and drinketh My Blood, abideth in Me, and I in him. As the living Father hath sent Me, and I live by the Father, so he that eateth Me, the same also shall live by Me. This is the bread that came down from Heaven. Not as your fathers did eat manna and are dead. He that eateth this Bread shall live for ever with you all days, even to the consummation of the world.

OFFERTORY (LEV. 21: 6)

The priests of the Lord offer incense and loaves to God, and therefore they shall be holy to their God, and shall not defile His name. Alleluia.

SECRET

We beseech Thee, O Lord, mercifully grant to Thy Church the gifts of unity and peace, which are mystically shown forth in these offerings made. Through our Lord.

COMMUNION (I COR. 11: 26-27)

As often as you shall eat this Bread and drink the Chalice, you shall show the death of the Lord until He come: therefore whosoever shall eat this Bread or drink the Chalice of the Lord unworthily, shall be guilty of the Body and Blood of the Lord. Alleluia.

POSTCOMMUNION

Grant us, we beseech Thee, O Lord, to be filled with the everlasting enjoyment of Thy divinity which is prefigured by the reception in this life of Thy precious Body and Blood: Who livest.

ABOVE: Thomas Aquinas shown presenting Lauda Sion to the Pope, Church of St. Nicholas, also known as the Dominican Church, Friesach, Austria. Lauda Sion was written by St. Thomas Aquinas around 1264, at the request of Pope Urban IV for the new Mass of this feast. The church is part of the oldest Dominican monastery in the German-speaking world, founded in 1217. We do not have a specific date for the above work.

INTROIT (Ps. 80: 17, 2)

He fed them with the fat of corn, alleluia, and filled them with honey out of the rock, alleluia, alleluia, alleluia. **Ps.** Rejoice to God our helper; sing aloud to the God of Jacob. ✠ Glory be to the Father.

COLLECT

O God, Who in this wonderful sacrament has left us a memorial of Thy passion: grant us, we beseech Thee, so to venerate the sacred mysteries of Thy Body and Blood, that we may ever perceive within us the fruit of Thy redemption. Who livest.

EPISTLE (I CORINTHIANS 11: 23-29)

Brethren, I have received of the Lord, that which also I delivered to you, that the Lord Jesus, the same night in which He was betrayed, took bread, and giving thanks, broke, and said: Take ye and eat, this is My Body which shall be delivered for you; this do for the commemoration of Me. In like manner also the chalice, after He had supped, saying:
