THIRD SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

INTROIT (Ps. 24: 16-18, 1, 2)

Look Thou upon me, O Lord, and have mercy on me; for I am alone and poor. See mine abjection and my labor; and forgive me all my sins, O my God. To Thee, O Lord, have I lifted up my soul, in Thee, my God, I put my trust; let me not be ashamed. Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Ghost. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen. — Look Thou upon me ...

COLLECT

O God, the Protector of those who put their trust in Thee, without whom nothing is strong, nothing holy: multiply upon us Thy mercy, that with Thee as our ruler and guide, we may so pass through things temporal, that we may not lose those which are eternal. Through our Lord ...

EPISTLE (I PET. 5: 6-11)

Dearly beloved: be you humbled, therefore, under the mighty hand of God; that he may exalt you in the time of visitation; casting all your solicitude upon him; for he hath care of you. Be sober, and watch, because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion, goeth about, seeking whom he may devour; who resist ye, strong in faith; knowing that the same affliction befalleth your brethren who are in the world. But the God of all grace, who hath called us unto his eternal glory in Christ Jesus, after you have suffered a little, will himself perfect you, and confirm you, and establish you. To him be glory and empire for ever and ever. Amen.

Cast thy care upon the Lord, and he will sustain thee Whilst I cried to the Lord, he heard my voice from them that draw near unto me.

GOSPEL (LK. 15: 1-10)

At that time: The publicans and sinners drew near unto Jesus to hear him. And the Pharisees and scribes murmured, saving: This man receiveth sinners and eateth with them. And he spoke to them this parable, saying: What man of you that hath a hundred sheep, and if he shall lose one of them, doth he not leave the ninety-nine in the desert, and go after that which was lost, until he find it? And when he hath found it, lay it upon his shoulders rejoicing, and coming home call together his friends and neighbors, saying to them: Rejoice with me, because I have found my sheep that was lost? I say to you, that even so there shall be joy in heaven upon one sinner that doth penance, more than upon ninety-nine just who need not penance. Or what woman having ten groats, if she lose one groat, doth not light a candle, and sweep the house, and seek diligently until she find it? And when she hath found it, call together her friends and neighbors, saying: Rejoice with me, because I have found the groat which I had lost. So I say to you, there shall be joy before the Angels of God upon one sinner doing penance.

OFFERTORY (Ps. 9: 11, 12, 13)

Let them trust in thee who know thy name, O Lord; for thou hast not forsaken them that seek thee: sing ye to the Lord, who dwelleth in Sion: for he hath not forgotten the cry of the poor.

SECRET

Look down, O Lord, on the offerings of thy suppliant Church; and grant that thy faithful may always in a holy manner partake of them unto their salvation. Through our Lord.

COMMUNION (Lk. 15: 10)

I say to you: There is joy before the Angels of God upon one sinner doing penance.

ALLELUIA (Ps. 7:12)

Alleluia, alleluia. V God is a just judge, strong and patient, is he angry every day? Alleluia.
