## PROPERS OF THE MASS ON JULY 28<sup>th</sup>, 2024 TENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

### INTROIT (Ps. 54: 17, 18, 20, 23, 2)

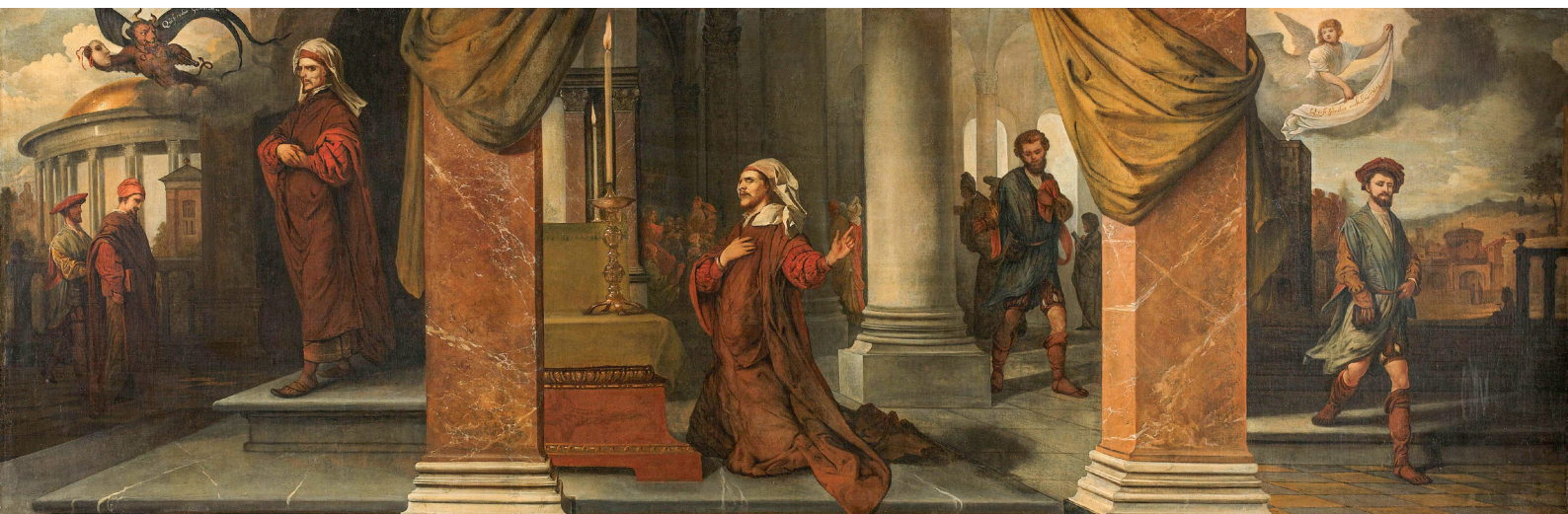
When I cried to the Lord He heard my voice, from them that draw near to me; and He humbled them, who is before all ages, and remains forever: cast thy care upon the Lord, and He shall sustain thee. **Ps.** Hear, O God, my prayer, and despise not my supplication; be attentive to me and hear me. **V** Glory be to the Father.

### COLLECT

God, who dost manifest Thy almighty power chiefly in showing mercy and pity; increase Thy mercy towards us, that we, seeking the way of Thy promises, may be made partakers of Thy heavenly treasures. Through our Lord.

### GOSPEL (Lk. 18: 9-14)

At that time Jesus spoke this parable to some who trusted in themselves as just, and despised others. Two men went up into the temple to pray; the one a Pharisee, and the other a Publican. The Pharisee standing, prayed thus with himself: O God, I give Thee thanks that I am not as the rest of men, extortioners, unjust, adulterers; as also is this publican. I fast twice in the week; I give tithes of all that I possess. And the Publican standing afar off would not so much as lift up his eyes towards heaven, but struck his breast saying: O God, be merciful to me a sinner. I say to you, this man went down to his house justified rather than the other: because everyone that exalteth himself shall be humbled, and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.



### EPISTLE (I COR. 12: 2-11)

Brethren, you know that, when you were heathens, you went to dumb idols, according as you were led. Wherefore I give you to understand, that no man, speaking by the Spirit of God, saith Anathema to Jesus; and no man can say: The Lord Jesus, but by the Holy Ghost. Now there are diversities of graces, but the same Spirit; and there are diversities of ministries, but the same Lord; and there are diversities of operations, but the same God, who worketh all in all. And the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man unto profit. To one indeed, by the Spirit, is given the word of wisdom; and to another, the word of knowledge, according to the same Spirit; to another the grace of healing in one Spirit; to another, the working of miracles; to another, prophecy; to another, the discerning of spirits; to another, divers kinds of tongues; to another, interpretation of speeches. But all these things one and the same Spirit worketh, dividing to every one according as He will.

### GRADUAL (Ps. 16: 8, 2)

Keep me, O Lord, as the apple of Thy eye: protect me under the shadow of Thy wings. **V** Let my judgment come forth from Thy countenance: let Thy eyes behold the things that are equitable.

### ALLELUIA (Ps. 64: 2)

Alleluia, alleluia. **V** A hymn, O God, becometh Thee in Sion: and a vow shall be paid to Thee in Jerusalem. Alleluia.

### OFFERTORY (Ps. 24: 1-3)

To Thee, O Lord, have I lifted up my soul: in Thee, O my God, I put my trust, let me not be ashamed: neither let my enemies laugh at me: for none of them that wait on Thee shall be confounded.

### SECRET

May these sacrifices, O Lord, which Thou hast appointed to be offered up to Thee for the glory of Thy name so be made holy, that they may become a remedy for all our ills. Through our Lord.

### COMMUNION (Ps. 50: 51, 21)

Thou wilt accept the sacrifice of justice, oblations and holocausts, upon Thy altar, O Lord.

### POSTCOMMUNION

Grant, we beseech Thee, O Lord our God, that Thy gracious help may never be lacking to us whose strength Thou ceasest not to renew with Thy divine sacraments. Through our Lord.

## SAINT IGNATIUS OF LOYOLA 31<sup>st</sup> JULY

Saint Ignatius of Loyola (1491 - 1556), with six companions, founded the religious order of the Society of Jesus and became its first Superior General in 1541. He had been a soldier, but experienced a great conversion during convalescence following a serious injury to his leg at the Battle of Pamplona. In 1522, during a visit to the Benedictine monastery of Santa Maria de Montserrat, he hung his sword and

dagger at the Virgin's altar during an overnight vigil and devoted the rest of his life to God. There is a stained glass window at Shrewsbury Cathedral which shows this scene.
