PROPERS OF THE MASS ON SEPTEMBER 1st, 2024 FIFTEENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

INTROIT (Ps. 85: 1, 2, 3, 4)

Incline Thine ear, O Lord, to me and hear me: save Thy servant, O my God, that trusteth in Thee: have mercy on me, O Lord, for I have cried to Thee all day. **Ps.** Give joy to the soul of Thy servant; for to Thee, O Lord, I have lifted up my soul. **V** Glory be to the Father.

COLLECT

Let Thy continual pity cleanse and defend Thy Church, we beseech Thee, O Lord; and because it cannot continue in safety without Thee, govern it evermore by Thy help. Through our Lord.

EPISTLE (GAL. 5: 25, 26; 6: 1-10)

Brethren: If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. Let us not be made desirous of vainglory, provoking one another, envying one another. Brethren, and if a man be overtaken in any fault, you, who are spiritual, instruct such a one in the spirit of meekness, considering thyself, lest thou also be tempted. Bear ye one another's burdens, and so you shall fulfil the law of Christ. For if any man think himself to be something, whereas he is nothing, he deceiveth himself. But let everyone prove his own work, and so he shall have glory in himself only, and not in another. For every one shall bear his own burden. And let him that is instructed in the word, communicate to him that instructeth him, in all good things. Be not deceived: God is not mocked; for what things a man shall sow, those also shall he reap. For he that soweth in his flesh, of the flesh also shall reap corruption: but he that soweth in the spirit, of the spirit shall reap life everlasting. And in doing good, let us not fail; for in due time we shall reap, not failing. Therefore, whilst we have time, let us work good to all men, but especially to those who are of the household of the faith.

GRADUAL (Ps. 91: 2-3)

It is good to give praise to the Lord; and to sing to Thy name, O Most High. **V** To show forth Thy mercy in the morning, and Thy truth in the night.

ALLELUIA (Ps. 94:3)

Alleluia, alleluia. **V** For the Lord is a great God, and a great King over all the earth. Alleluia.

GOSPEL (Lk. 7: 11-16)

At that time, Jesus went into a city called Naim; and there went with Him His disciples, and a great multitude. And when He came nigh to the city, behold a dead man was carried out, the only son of his mother, and she was a widow, and a great multitude of the city were with her. And when the Lord saw her, He had compassion on her, and said to her: Weep not. And He came near and touched the bier. And they that carried it stood still. And He said: Young man, I say to thee, Arise: and he that was dead sat up, and began to speak. And He delivered him to his mother. And there came a fear on them all: and they glorified God, saying: A great prophet is risen up amongst us, and God hath visited His people.

OFFERTORY (Ps. 39: 2, 3, 4)

With expectation I have waited for the Lord, and He had regard to me; and he heard my prayer, and He put a new canticle into my mouth, a song to our God.

COMMUNION (Jn. 6: 52)

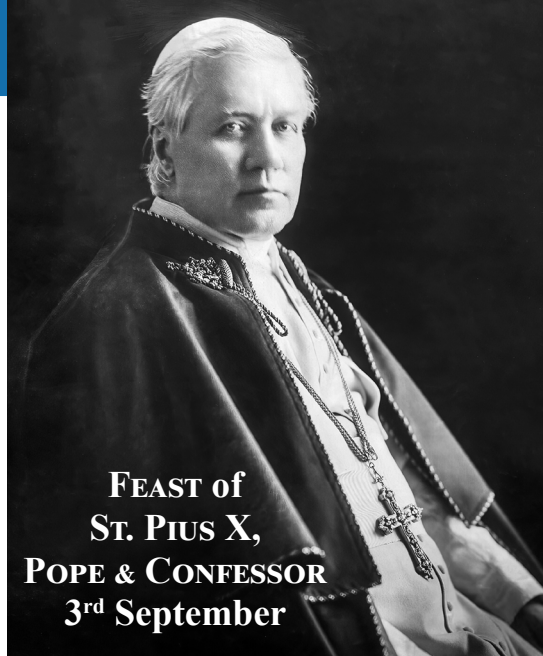
The bread that I will give is My flesh for the life of the world.

FEAST OF ST. PIUS X, POPE & CONFESSOR 3rd September

Giuseppe Melchiorre Sarto was born on 2nd June 1835 in Riese, Treviso, Lombardy. He died on 20th August 1914 (aged 79). His papacy spanned the period 4th August 1903 until his death. He was beatified in 1951 and canonized in 1954 by Pope Pius XII. His motto was *Instaurare Omnia in Christo* (To restore all things in Christ).

One of Pius X's great works was to lower the age of First Holy Communion for children. His 1910 decree *Quam Singulari* says:

“... it is clear that the age of discretion for receiving Holy Communion is that at which the child knows the difference between the Eucharistic Bread and ordinary, material bread, and can therefore approach the altar with proper devotion. Perfect knowledge of the things of faith, therefore, is not required, for an elementary knowledge suffices - some knowledge (*aliqua cognitio*); similarly full use of reason is not required, for a certain beginning of the use of reason, that is, some use of reason (*aliqualis usus rationis*) suffices.”
