PROPERS OF THE MASS ON MARCH 23rd, 2025

THIRD SUNDAY IN LENT

INTROIT (Ps. 24: 15, 16, 1, 2)

My eyes are ever toward the Lord, for He shall free my feet from the snare. Look upon me, and have pity on me, for I am alone and wretched. Ps. 24:1-2. I have lifted up my soul to You, O my God; in You I place my trust. Let me not be put to shame. *V* Glory be ...

COLLECT

We beseech The, O almighty God, look upon the desires of the humble: and stretch forth the right hand of Thy Majesty to be our defense. Through Our Lord . . .

EPISTLE (EPH. 5: 1-9)

Brethren: Be ye therefore followers of God, as most dear children: And walk in love, as Christ also hath loved us and hath delivered himself for us, an oblation and a sacrifice to God for an odour of sweetness. But fornication and all uncleanness or covetousness, let it not so much as be named among you, as becometh saints: Or obscenity or foolish talking or scurrility, which is to no purpose: but rather giving of thanks. For know you this and understand: That no fornicator or unclean or covetous person (which is a serving of idols) hath inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God. Let no man deceive you with vain words. For because of these things cometh the anger of God upon the children of unbelief. Be ye not therefore partakers with them. For you were heretofore darkness, but now light in the Lord. Walk then as children of the light. For the fruit of the light is in all goodness and justice and truth.

GRADUAL (Ps. 9: 20, 4)

Arise, O Lord, let not man prevail; let the nations be judged in Your presence. *V* When my enemies shall be turned back, they shall be weakened and destroyed before you.

TRACT (Ps. 122: 1-3)

To You who are enthroned in heaven, have I lifted up my eyes. *V* Behold, as the eyes of servants are on the hands of their masters. *V* And as the eyes of a maid are on the hands of her mistress, so are our eyes on the Lord, our God, until He have pity on us. *V* Have mercy on us, O Lord, have mercy.

GOSPEL (Lk. 11: 14-28)

At that time, Jesus was casting out a devil: and the same was dumb. And when he had cast out the devil, the dumb spoke: and the multitudes, were in admiration at it. But some of them said: "He casteth out devils by Beelzebub, the prince of devils." And others

tempting, asked of him a sign from heaven. But he seeing their thoughts, said to them: "Every kingdom divided against itself shall be brought to desolation; and house upon house shall fall. And if Satan also be divided against himself, how shall his kingdom stand? Because you say that through Beelzebub I cast out devils. Now if I cast out devils by Beelzebub, by whom do your children cast them out? Therefore, they shall be your judges. But if I by the finger of God cast out devils, doubtless the kingdom of God is come upon you. When a strong man armed keepeth his court, those things are

in peace which he possesseth. But if a stronger than he come upon him and overcome him, he will take away all his armour wherein he trusted and will distribute his spoils. He that is not with me is against me; and he that gathereth not with me scattereth. When the unclean spirit is gone out of a man, he walketh through places without water, seeking rest: and not finding, he saith: I will return into my house whence I came out. And when he is come, he findeth it swept and garnished. Then he goeth and taketh with him seven other spirits more wicked than himself: and entering in they dwell there. And the last state of that man becomes worse than the first." And it came to pass, as he spoke these things, a certain woman from the crowd, lifting up her voice, said to him: "Blessed is the womb that bore thee and the paps that gave thee suck." But he said: "Yea rather, blessed are they who hear the word of God and keep it."

OFFERTORY (Ps. 18: 9, 11, 12)

The precepts of the Lord are right, rejoicing the heart, and His judgments are sweeter than honey and the honeycomb; for Your servant observes them.

SECRET

May this Victim, O Lord, we beseech Thee, cleanse away our sins: and by sanctifying Thy servants in body and mind, make them fit to celebrate this Sacrifice. Through Our Lord . . .

COMMUNION (Ps. 83: 4, 5)

The sparrow has found herself a home, and the turtledove a nest in which to lay her young: Thy altars, O Lord of hosts, my king and my God! Blessed are they who dwell in Thy house; they shall praise Thee forever and ever.

POSTCOMMUNION

In Thy mercy, we beseech Thee, O Lord, do Thou from all guilt and peril absolve us, whom Thou grantest to be sharers in so great a mystery. Through Our Lord . . .
