Propers of the Mass on August 24th, 2025

ELEVENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

Introit (Ps. 67: 6-7, 36, 2)

God in His holy place; God who maketh men of one mind to dwell in a house: He shall give power and strength to His people. Ps. Let God arise, and let His enemies be scattered: and let them that hate Him flee from before His face. W Glory be to the Father.

COLLECT

Almighty and eternal God, Who in the abundance of Thy loving kindness art wont to give beyond the deserts and desires of those who humbly pray; pour down upon us Thy mercy, forgiving us these things of which our conscience is afraid, and granting us those blessings which we dare not presume to ask. Through our Lord.

Epistle (I Cor. 15: 1-10)

Brethren: I make known unto you the gospel which I preached to you, which also you have received, and wherein you stand, by which also you are saved, if you hold fast after what manner I preached unto you, unless you have believed in vain. For I delivered unto

you first of all, which I also received, how that Christ died for our sins according to the Scriptures; and that He was buried, and that He rose again the third day according to the Scriptures; and that He was seen by Cephas, and after that by the eleven. Then was He seen by more than five hundred brethren at once; of whom many remain until this present, and some are fallen asleep. After that He was seen by James then by all the apostles. And last of all He was seen also by me, as by one born out of due time. For I am the least of the apostles, who am not worthy to be called an apostle, because I persecuted the church of God; but by the grace of God I am what I am; and His grace in me hath not been void.

Gradual (Ps. 27: 7, 1)

In God hath my heart confided, and I have been helped; and my flesh hath flourished again; and with my will I will give praise to Him. V Unto Thee will I cry, O Lord: O my God, be not Thou silent; depart not from me.

ALLELUIA (Ps. 80: 2, 3)

Alleluia, alleluia. W Rejoice to God our helper; sing aloud to the God of Jacob; take a pleasant psalm with the harp. Alleluia.

GOSPEL (MK. 7: 31-37)

At that time, Jesus going out of the coasts of Tyre, came by Sidon to the sea of Galilee, through the midst of the coasts of Decapolis. And they bring to Him one deaf and dumb,

and they besought Him that He would lay His hand upon him. And taking him from the multitude apart, He put His fingers into his ears, and spitting, He touched his tongue; and looking up to heaven, He groaned and said to him: Ephphetha, which is, Be thou opened: and immediately his ears were opened, and the string of his tongue was loosed, and he spoke right. And He charged them that they should tell no man: but the more He charged them so much the more a great deal did they publish it; and so much the more did they wonder, saying: He hath done all things well; He hath made both the deaf to hear and the dumb to speak.

OFFERTORY (Ps. 29: 2-3)

I will extol Thee, O Lord, for Thou hast upheld me; and hast not made my enemies to rejoice over me: O Lord, I have cried to Thee, and Thou hast healed me.

SECRET

Look down in mercy upon our service, we beseech Thee, O Lord, that the gifts we offer may be acceptable unto Thee, and a support in our weakness. Through our Lord.

Communion (Prov. 3: 9, 10)

Honor the Lord with thy substance, and with the first of all thy fruits: and thy barns shall be filled with abundance, and thy presses shall run over with wine.

Postcommunion

Having received Thy holy sacrament, we beseech Thee, O Lord, that we may feel supported in soul and body; that being saved in both, we may glory in the fullness of the heavenly remedy. Through our Lord.

BEHEADING OF SAINT JOHN THE BAPTIST - 29th August

John the Baptist rebuked Herod for marrying his brother's wife, Herodias, while his brother was still living. When Salome, the daughter of Herodias, danced for Herod, he offered to give the girl whatever she asked for. Herodias, infuriated by John's rebuke told Salome to demand John's head on a dish. Herod felt bound to keep his promise and so had John beheaded.

Centuries later. when Henry VIII wanted his marriage to Katherine of Aragon to be annulled, and bearing in mind that the Pope's approval of this marriage had been sought and granted, Saint John Fisher spoke in defence of the Catholic teaching on the indissolubility of marriage. For this and his defence of the Church, Fisher was beheaded. People noted the similarity of his fate to that of John the Baptist.
