SIXTEENTH SUNDAY AFTER PENTECOST

INTROIT (Ps. 85: 3, 5, 1)

Have mercy on me, O Lord, for I have cried to Thee all the day; for Thou, O Lord, art sweet and mild and plenteous in mercy to all that call upon Thee. **Ps.** Incline Thy ear to me, O Lord, and hear me; for I am needy and poor. **V** Glory be to the Father.

COLLECT

O Lord, we pray Thee that Thy grace may always precede and follow us, and make us continually intent upon all good works. Through our Lord.

COMM. NATIVITY OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN:

Bestow upon Thy servants, we beseech Thee, O Lord, the gift of Thy heavenly grace: that as the childbearing of the Blessed Virgin was the beginning of our salvation, so the solemn feast of her Nativity may bring us an increase of peace. Through our Lord.

EPISTLE EPH. 3: 13-21)

Brethren: I pray you not to faint at my tribulations for you, which are your glory. For this cause I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, of whom all paternity in heaven and earth is named, that He would grant you, according to the riches of His glory, to be strengthened by His Spirit with might unto the inward man. That Christ may dwell by faith in your hearts; that being rooted and founded in charity, you may be able to comprehend with all the saints, what is the breadth and length, and height, and depth. To know also the charity of Christ, which surpasseth all knowledge; that you may be filled unto all the fullness of God. Now to Him who is able to do all things more abundantly than we desire or understand, according to the power that worketh in us: to Him be glory in the Church, and in Christ Jesus, unto all generations, world without end. Amen.

GRADUAL (Ps. 101: 16-17)

The Gentiles shall fear Thy name, O Lord, and all the kings of the earth Thy glory. **V** For the Lord hath built up Sion, and He shall be seen in His majesty.

ALLELUIA (Ps. 97: 1)

Alleluia, alleluia. **V** Sing ye to the Lord a new canticle, because the Lord hath done wonderful things. Alleluia.

GOSPEL (Lk. 14: 1-11)

At that time, when Jesus went into the house of one of the chief of the Pharisees on the Sabbath day to eat bread, they watched Him. And behold, there was a certain man before Him that had dropsy: and Jesus answering, spoke to the lawyers and Pharisees, saying: Is it lawful to heal on the Sabbath day? But they held their peace: but He taking him, healed him, and sent him away. And answering them, He said: Which of you shall have an ass or an ox fall into a pit, and will not immediately draw him out on the Sabbath day? And they could not answer Him these things. And He spoke a parable also to them that were invited, marking how they chose the first seats at the table, saying to them: When thou art invited to a wedding, sit not down in the first place, lest perhaps one more honorable than thou be invited by him; and he that invited thee and him, come and say to thee: Give this man place; and then, thou begin with shame to take the lowest place. But when thou art invited, go, sit down in the lowest place: that when he who invited thee cometh, he may say to thee: Friend, go up higher: then shalt thou have glory before them that sit at table with thee: because everyone that exalteth himself shall be humbled, and he that humbleth himself shall be exalted.

OFFERTORY (Ps. 39: 14, 15)

Look down, O Lord, to help me; let them be confounded and ashamed that seek after my soul to take it away; look down, O Lord, to help me.

SECRET

Cleanse our hearts, we beseech Thee, O Lord, through the effects of this sacrifice: and in Thy mercy make us worthy to partake thereof. Through our Lord.

COMM. NATIVITY OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN:

May the Incarnation of Thine only-begotten Son, O Lord, come to help us: He Whose birth from a maiden did not spoil but sealed her virginity: may He, on this festival of her Nativity, cleanse us from sin and make our offering pleasing in Thy sight, Jesus Christ our Lord, Who with Thee liveth and reigneth.

COMMUNION (Ps. 70: 16, 17, 18)

O Lord, I will be mindful of Thy justice alone: Thou hast taught me, O God, from my youth, and unto old age and grey hairs, O God, forsake me not.

POSTCOMMUNION

In Thy loving kindness, O Lord, purify our souls, we beseech Thee, and renew them by this heavenly sacrament, that in both the present and future, even our bodies therein may find relief. Through our Lord.

COMM. NATIVITY OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN:

We have received, O Lord, the Sacraments offered on this yearly feast: grant we beseech Thee, that they may bestow on us remedies both for this present life and for the life eternal. Through Our Lord.
