INTROIT (4 ESDR. 2: 34-35)

O God, Creator and Redeemer of all the faithful, grant to the souls of Your servants and handmaids the remission of all their sins, that they may obtain by our loving prayers the forgiveness which they have always desired.

Epistle (2 Mach. 12: 43-46)

In those days: The most valiant man Judas, making a gathering, sent twelve thousand drachmas of silver to Jerusalem for sacrifice to be offered for the sins of the dead, thinking well and religiously concerning the resurrection, for if he had not hoped that they that were slain should rise again, it would have seemed superfluous and vain to pray for the dead; and because he considered that they who had fallen asleep with godliness, had great grace laid up for them. It is therefore a holy and wholesome thought to pray for the dead, that they may be loosed from sins.

Eternal rest give to them, O Lord; and let perpetual light shine upon them. The just man shall be in everlasting remembrance; an evil report he shall not fear.

SEQUENTIA DIES IRAE

GOSPEL (JOHN 6: 37-40)

At that time, Jesus said to the multitude of the Jews, All that the Father gives to Me shall come to Me, and him who comes to Me I will not cast out. For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him Who sent Me. Now this is the will of Him Who sent Me, the Father, that I should lose nothing of what He has given Me, but that I should raise it up

on the last day. For this is the will of My Father Who sent Me, that whoever beholds the Son, and believes in Him, shall have everlasting life, and I will raise him up on the last day.

OFFERTORY

O Lord, Jesus Christ, King of glory, deliver the souls of all the faithful departed from the pains of hell and the deep pit; deliver them from the lion's mouth, that hell engulf them not, nor they fall into darkness, but that Michael, the holy standard-bearer, bring them into the holy light which You once promised to Abraham and his seed. We offer You, O Lord, sacrifices and prayers of praise; accept them for those souls whom we this day commemorate; grant them, O Lord, to pass from death to the life which You once promised to Abraham and his seed.

SECRET



SAINT ALBERT THE GREAT Feast Day: 15th November

Albert the Great, born in Lauingen in Bavaria around 1200, was one of the greatest and most productive medieval scholars. His long and productive academic career produced many contributions in the areas of natural science, theology and philosophy. He was a Dominican and became the teacher of yet another outstanding Dominican, Saint Thomas Aquinas. For a time he served as Bishop of Regensberg and was assigned to preach the Eighth Crusade in German-speaking countries. His impressive accomplishments are too numerous to describe here, but it is worth looking up his biographical details. He was beatified in 1622 and canonized and made a Doctor of the Church in 1931 by Pius XI. He is the patron saint of scientists.
