EPISTLE (PHIL 3:17-21; 4:1-3)

Brethren: Be ye followers of me, and observe them who walk so as you have our model. For many walk, of whom I have told you often (and now tell you weeping), that they are enemies of the cross of Christ; whose end is destruction, whose God is their belly, and whose glory is in their shame; who mind earthly things. But our conversation is in heaven, from whence also we look for the Savior, our Lord Jesus Christ, who will reform the body of our lowliness, made like to the body of His glory, according to the operation whereby also He is able to subdue all things unto Himself. Therefore, my brethren, dearly beloved, and most desired, my joy and my crown: so stand fast in the Lord, my dearly beloved. I beg of Evodia, and I beseech Syntyche to be of one mind in the Lord: and I entreat thee also, my sincere companion, help those women who have labored with me in the Gospel, with Clement and the rest of my fellow laborers, whose names are in the book of life.

GOSPEL (MT. 9:18-26)

At that time, as Jesus was speaking to the multitudes, behold a certain ruler came up, and adored Him, saying: Lord, my daughter is even now dead; but come lay Thy hand upon her, and she shall live. And Jesus, rising up, followed him, with His disciples. And behold a woman, who was troubled with an issue of blood twelve years, came behind Him, and touched the hem

of His garment. For she said within herself: If I shall touch only His garment, I shall be healed. But Jesus turning and seeing her, said: Be of good heart, daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole. And the woman was made whole from that hour. And when Jesus was come, into the house of the ruler, and saw the minstrels and the multitude making a tumult, He said: Give place; for the girl is not dead, but sleepeth. And they laughed Him to scorn. And when the multitude was put forth, He went in and took her by the hand. And the maid arose. And the fame thereof went abroad into all that country.

SAINT CECILIA

Feast Day: 22nd November - Mass 10.00 am

Saint Cecilia, a Roman virgin of noble birth, was martyred around the year 230, with her husband Valerian, his brother Tiburtius, and a Roman soldier named Maximus. She had vowed her virginity to God at an early age, but was given in marriage against her will to the pagan Valerian. Cecilia persuaded him to leave her a virgin and be baptized. He then converted his brother, Tiburtius. All three were martyred. In 1599, her tomb was opened and, according to multiple witnesses, her body was found to be still incorrupt. It is said that she sang to God during her wedding and she is the patron saint of musicians.
