Propers of the Mass on February 8th, 2026 EXTERNAL SOLEMNITY OF THE PURIFICATION OF THE BLESSED VIRGIN MARY - (CANDLEMAS DAY)

INTROIT (Ps 47: 10, 11)

We have received Thy mercy, O God, in the midst of Thy temple; according to Thy Name, O God, so also is Thy praise unto the ends of the earth: Thy right hand is full of justice. **Psalm.** Great is the Lord, and exceedingly to be praised, in the city of God, in His holy mountain. - Glory be to the Father, and to the Son, and to the Holy Ghost. As it was in the beginning, is now, and ever shall be, world without end. Amen. — We have received Thy mercy ...

COLLECT

Almighty and everlasting God, we humbly beseech Thy Majesty, that as Thine only begotten Son was this day presented in the temple in substance of our flesh, so Thou wouldst cause us, too, with purified hearts to be presented unto Thee. Through the same Jesus Christ, Thy Son, our Lord ...

EPISTLE (MALACHIAS 3: 1-4)

Thus saith the Lord God: Behold I send Mine Angel, and he shall prepare the way before My face; and presently the Lord whom you seek, and the Angel of the testament whom you desire, shall come to His temple.

Behold He cometh, saith the Lord of hosts: and who shall be able to think of the day of His coming? and who shall stand to see Him? for he is like a refining fire and like the fuller's herb; and he shall sit refining and cleansing the silver, and He shall purify the sons of Levi, and shall refine them as gold and as silver, and they shall offer sacrifices to the Lord in justice. And the sacrifice of Juda and of Jerusalem shall please the Lord, as in the days of old and in the ancient years; saith the Lord almighty.

GRADUAL (PSALM 47: 10-11, 9)

ALLELUIA (ST. AUGUSTINE)

Alleluia, alleluia. **V** An old man was carrying a Child; but the Child was the old man's Lord. Alleluia.

GOSPEL (LUKE 2: 22-32)

At that time, after the days of Mary's purification, according to the law of Moses, were accomplished, they carried Jesus to Jerusalem, to present Him to the Lord; as it is written in the law of the Lord: Every male opening the womb shall be called holy to the Lord; and to offer a sacrifice, according as it is written in the law of the Lord, a pair of turtle doves, or two young pigeons. And behold there was a man in Jerusalem named Simeon, and this man was just and devout, waiting for the consolation of Israel, and the Holy Ghost was in him: and he had received an answer from the Holy Ghost, that he should not see death, before he had seen the Christ of the Lord. And he came by the Spirit into the temple.

And when His parents brought in the Child Jesus, to do for Him according to the custom of the law, he also took Him into his arms, and blessed God, and said: Now Thou dost dismiss Thy servant, O Lord, according to Thy word in peace; because mine eyes have seen Thy salvation, which Thou hast prepared before the face of all peoples; a light to the revelation of the Gentiles, and the glory of Thy people Israel.

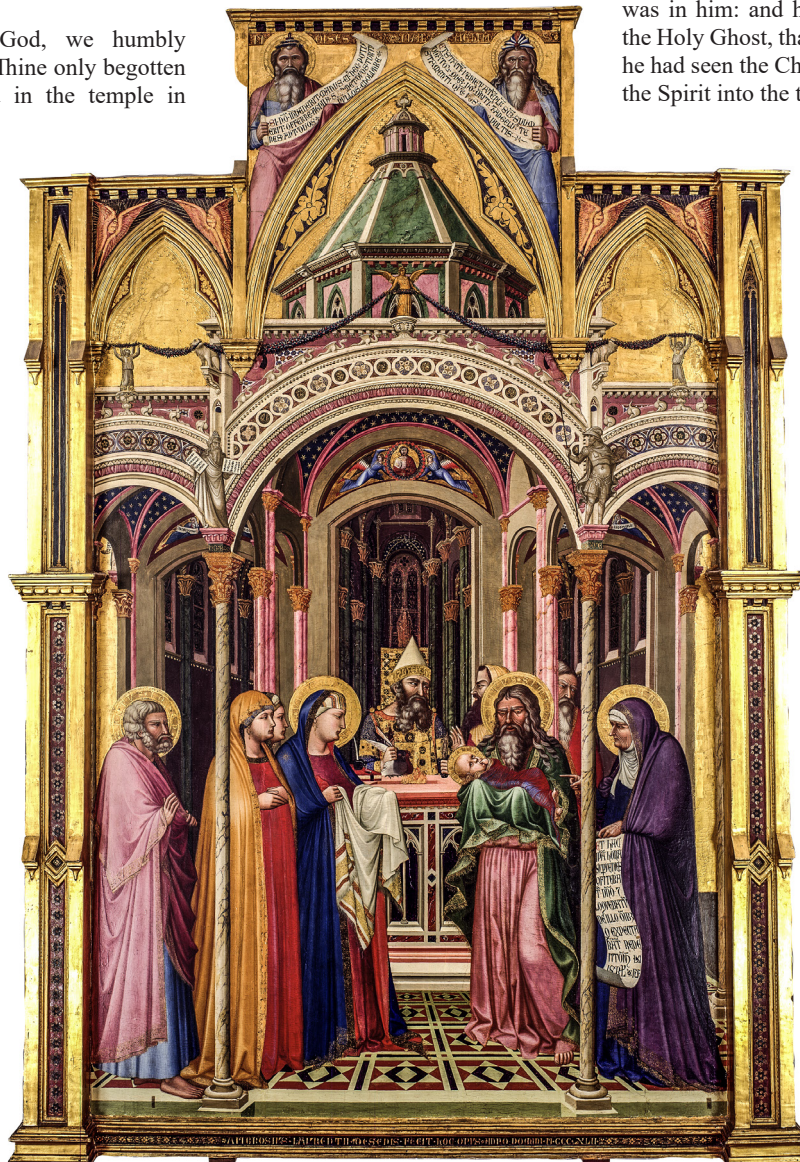
COMMUNION (LUKE 2: 26)

SAINT SCHOLASTICA: 10th February, Mass 6:30pm

Scholastica was the twin sister of Saint Benedict. She lived as a nun in a convent near Montecassino and would meet with her brother once a year. During the last visit before her death, as it grew late, Scholastica pleaded with Benedict to stay on, and when he refused, saying that he must return to the monastery in accordance with the rule, she prayed to God and suddenly the weather turned so stormy that Benedict and the monks who had accompanied him could not return. He said to her 'Sister. What hast thou done?' She replied that God had granted her the favour that Benedict had refused. They spent the night in holy conversation. Three days later Benedict saw the soul of Scholastica going up to heaven in the shape of a dove. Dom Guéranger says that 'Our season is appropriate for the beautiful lesson taught us by St. Scholastica, a fraternal charity.' - The Liturgical Year, Septuagesima
