## Propers of the Mass on May 10<sup>th</sup>, 2026 FIFTH SUNDAY AFTER EASTER

### INTROIT (Is: 48: 20; Ps. 65: 1-2)

Declare it with the voice of joy and let it be heard, alleluia! Announce it to the ends of the earth: the Lord has delivered His people, alleluia, alleluia! **Ps. 65:1-2.** Shout joyfully to God, all the earth; sing a psalm to the glory of His name; proclaim His glorious praise. **V** Glory be . . .

### COLLECT

O God, the source of all good, grant us Your inspiration that we may have proper thoughts, and Your guidance that we may carry them into practice. Through Our Lord . . .

### EPISTLE (JAMES 1: 22-27)

Beloved: But be ye doers of the word and not hearers only, deceiving your own selves. For if a man be a hearer of the word and not a doer, he shall be compared to a man beholding his own countenance in a glass. For he beheld himself and went his way and presently forgot what manner of man he was. But he that hath looked into the perfect law of liberty and hath continued therein, not becoming a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work: this man shall be blessed in his deed. And if any man think himself to be religious, not bridling his tongue but deceiving his own heart, this man's religion is vain. Religion clean and undefiled before God and the Father is this: to visit the fatherless and widows in their tribulation and to keep one's self unspotted from this world.

### PASCHAL ALLELUIA (Jn. 16: 28)

Alleluia, alleluia! **V** Christ has risen and has given light to us, whom He redeemed with His Blood. Alleluia! **V John 16:28.** I came forth from the Father and have come into the world. Again I leave the world and go to the Father. Alleluia!

### GOSPEL (Jn. 16: 23-30)

At that time, Jesus said to His disciples: "Amen, amen, I say to you: if you ask the Father anything in my name, he will give it you. Hitherto, you have not asked anything in my name. Ask, and you shall receive; that your joy may be full." "These things I have spoken to you in proverbs. The hour cometh when I will no longer speak to you in proverbs, but will shew you plainly of the Father. In that day, you shall ask in my name: and I say not to you that I will ask the Father for you. For the Father himself loveth you, because you have loved me and have believed that I came out from God. I came forth from the Father and am come into the world: again I leave the world and I go to the Father." His disciples say to him: "Behold, now thou speakest plainly and speakest no proverb. Now we know that thou knowest all things and thou needest not that any man should ask thee. By this we believe that thou camest forth from God."

### OFFERTORY (Ps. 65: 8-9, 20)

Bless the Lord our God, you nations; loudly sound His praise. he has given life to my soul, and has not let my feet falter. Blessed be the Lord who has not refused my prayer nor His mercy to me, alleluia!

### SECRET

Accept the prayers and offering of the faithful, O Lord, and let our love and devotion lead us to the glory of heaven. Through our Lord . . .



### COMMUNION (Ps. 95: 2)

Sing to the Lord, alleluia! Sing to the Lord, and bless His name; announce His salvation day after day, alleluia, alleluia!

### POSTCOMMUNION

Grant that we, who have been fed at Your Heavenly Banquet, O Lord, may desire only what is right and that we may fulfill these holy desires. Through Our Lord . . .
